

GRIM GUNS LIE BEHIND HAWAII'S PERFECT VISTA

President to See 'Paradise,'
Potential Theater of
'Greatest' War.

Islands once ruled by a king for the first time in history will greet a President of the United States. In the following account the author of this Dan Campbell, for four years United Press staff correspondent at Honolulu, relates some of the popular conceptions as to what Franklin D. Roosevelt probably will see in the "Paradise of the Pacific."

Aboard one of the nation's most modern fighting units, the "Big Navy," President of the United States is steaming today toward what is popularly confused with a Harlem "hot spot" of hula girls, honeymoons and soft harmony.

Actually, it is the potential theater of the greatest naval conflict in history.

While President Roosevelt could have chosen no more favorable spot for an outdoor vacation, if he desires he can view the most formidable display of combined army and navy strength under his command.

Over trails once marked by the out-rigger canoes of the Polynesians and followed by the sampans of ancient Japanese fishermen, whalers of all nations and the missionary-bearing sloops of New England, the trim cruiser Houston will bring Franklin D. Roosevelt to Honolulu.

Peace Is Believed

The cruiser will round somnolent Diamond Head, which shelters famed Waikiki beach, and is to Pacific tourists a symbol of these peaceful isles.

But well may it belch smoke and deadly fire from its long dead crater, its revival man-made with the army mortars that comprise part of the defenses of Ft. Ruger, situated on its slope.

Further down the beach front, a booming twenty-one-gun salute will begin as the Houston swings toward the narrow harbor entrance. The coast artillery of Ft. DeRussey will hail a chief, but it is equally prepared to hail an enemy.

Discovered by an Englishman, these islands, upon which the President will land, are American soil because the missionaries not only planted their faith, but their flag; overthrew a queen, established a republic and in 1898 turned them over to the United States.

City of Sunshine

When Mr. Roosevelt steps ashore he will find a modern city in which business is permitted to move at a bustling pace by the cooling trade winds; agriculture to flourish by virtue of unending sunshine and abundant rainfall and intermingling races living in a harmony that Kipling denied.

Holiday offer every modern comfort; white breaker-combed beaches offer relaxation; fishing and swimming—the sport at which the President excels—unequaled anywhere in the world.

If he desires, he may fly over the extinct and harmlessly active volcanoes of the islands, view the checkered rice paddies, rolling fields of sugar cane, green dotted acres of pineapples and plantations of tobacco and coffee.

Beauty Curtains Grimness

The streets through which he drives will be lined by shower trees of yellow and red, and shaded by giant banyans draped with bougainvillea and the night blooming cereus.

But back of this garlanded curtain is a backdrop of grimness. Behind picturesque palms, rolling lawns and green hedges are the mighty guns of Ft. DeRussey, Ft. Ruger, Ft. Shaffer, Ft. Kamehameha, and the barracks of Schofield, housing 15,000 men and the only complete army division in the United States.

Hawaii may be a real "hot spot" some day and without benefit of ukulele.






