

# PLEAS LEAVES COPS' CASE UP TO GOVERNOR

Patronage Secretary Turns  
Back on Cases of Two  
State Policemen.

Pleas Greenlee, Governor Paul V. McNutt's patronage secretary, today "washed his hands" of the case of two state policemen dismissed for neglect of duty by Al G. Feeney, state safety director.

Any further action in the case must come from the Governor, according to Mr. Greenlee.

The dismissed policemen are John Hamilton, Sullivan, and Guy Engle, Carbon. They were found guilty by Feeney of neglect of duty in permitting an auto theft suspect to escape.

Persons influential in the McNutt administration are reported to have interceded vainly for the men. Hamilton is a political appointee from the district where Paul Fry, state excise director, is chairman.

# IRATE PARENT'S RIFLE CLOSES DISPUTE ON CAPTURE OF MONKEY

HARTFORD, Conn., July 20.—While Hartford officials passed the "buck" on who was to capture a forty-pound monkey, escaped from a circus, an irate parent whose child had been clawed, took a gun down from its rack and blazed away.

Bennett, Granite City, Ill., and George Williams, Canonsburg, Pa. It was reported that Williams would withdraw later because of his unwillingness to oppose Tighe. The elections will be held in September.
