LIQUOR LAW TIGHTENED

Rectifiers Placed Under Control of
Alcohol Tax Unit.

Helvering, internal revenue commissioner, placing all liquor rectifiers under control of the alcohol tax unit. The regulation will be effective Sept. 1 and will subject rectifying plants to rigid government inspection.

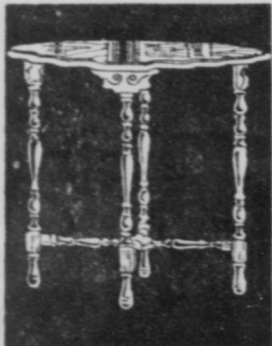
