

ANNIVERSARY TO HONOR FOUNDER OF T. B. GROUP

Marion County Association Will Observe 50 Years of Movement.

The fiftieth anniversary of the building of the first sanatorium for the cure of tuberculosis will be observed at a meeting at noon tomorrow of the Bridgeport nutrition camp committee of the Marion County Tuberculosis Association.

The late Dr. Edward Livingston Trudeau, founder of the tuberculosis sanatorium movement, erected the first sanatorium at Saranac Lake, N. Y., in 1884. Since that time, sanatoriums have increased to more than 650 in number throughout the United States and there are more than 80,000 sanatorium beds. Reports at tomorrow's meeting will be made by Miss Louise Dumas, nutrition camp director; Miss Flora Dutcher, nurse; Dr. E. O. Asher, camp physician; Mrs. Alexander Jameson, committee secretary, and John Lauck Jr., committee chairman. The meeting will be held at the Lincoln.

BRITISH EXPERT INSPECTS CITY'S RAIL SYSTEM

Trackless Trolleys Impress T. E. Thomas, London Tramway.

The general manager of the world's largest unified transportation system was in Indianapolis today to inspect what he called the "most modern transportation system in the world," that of the Indianapolis Railways.

Crisp, efficient T. E. Thomas, London (England) passenger transport board general manager, said

he was greatly impressed by the Indianapolis method of using trackless trolleys for transportation and that he hopes that London will have 500 of them next year.

In commenting on the new London ruling that motor vehicles can not "hoot," or blow horns, between 11 p. m. and 7 a. m., Mr. Thomas said:

"The ruling, which has been most successful, proves that hooting is a mental habit rather than a necessity."

"I came here to Indianapolis," he added, "because we had learned that you have the most modern equipment in the world. The officials of Indianapolis Railways have been most kind in answering the volley of questions we have asked."

The greatest competitor to the London transport board is the bicycle, Mr. Thomas revealed.

"In the evening after the shops have closed, the streets are filled with a flow of bicycles," he explained. "The people buy them with

a \$1 down payment and 50 cents a week."

The London and Indianapolis transportation systems are similar in that they both use every type vehicle to provide the best means of transportation, Mr. Thomas believes. Mr. Thomas was particularly pleased with the safety zones provided for street car passengers here.

"We have been trying to get them in London for some time but have

succeeded only in a few instances,"
