

COUNTY T. B. GROUP ISSUES FUNDS APPEAL

3500 Residents Fail to File Report on Christmas Seal Sales.

An increasing number of calls from persons asking assistance from the Marion County Tuberculosis Association today prompted the health agency to appeal for funds to meet the demands.

The organization, through its president, Dr. E. M. Amos, is asking residents of Marion County who have not done so, to pay for their 1934 tuberculosis Christmas seals.

"Seals were mailed in December to thousands of residents of the county and the majority paid for all of their seals," Dr. Amos said. "In some instances, extra gifts were received. There are, however, approximately 3500 residents who have made no report and we are asking them to do so now. We feel as though it is merely that they have forgotten about the matter."

It is pointed out that the association is responsible for all seals furnished in Marion County.

"Gifts are needed more now than ever in the face of conditions that encourage the spread of tuberculosis," Dr. Amos said. "More than 2600 persons in Marion County are victims of this disease."

Work of the association is made possible only through its annual sale of Christmas Seals.
