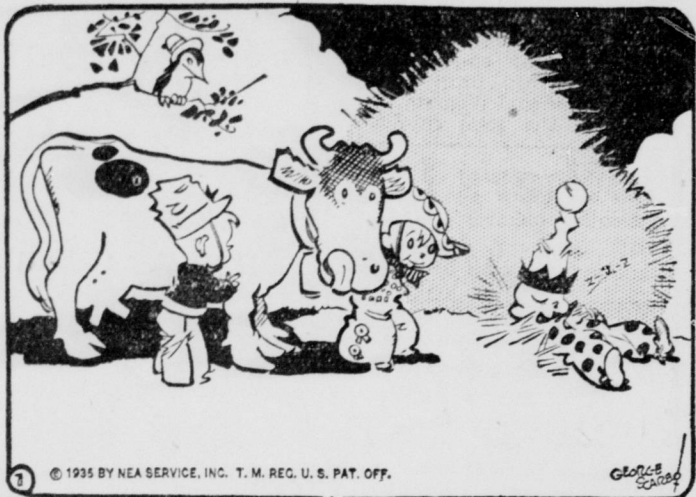


THE TINYMITES

They got the cow and started out. Soon Scouty heard wee Coppy shout, "Gee, you were right. There's Duncy, sound asleep, sprawled in some hay."

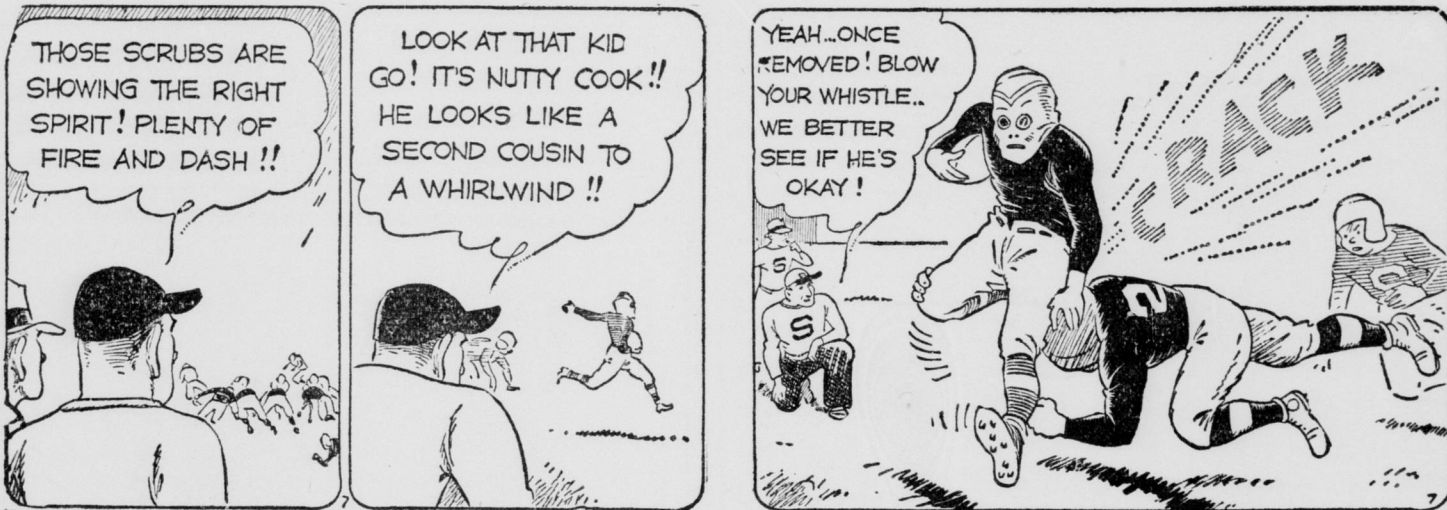
"All right, the next thing we will do is try to make this big cow moo," said Scouty. "I'll bet Duncy jumps and tries to runaway."

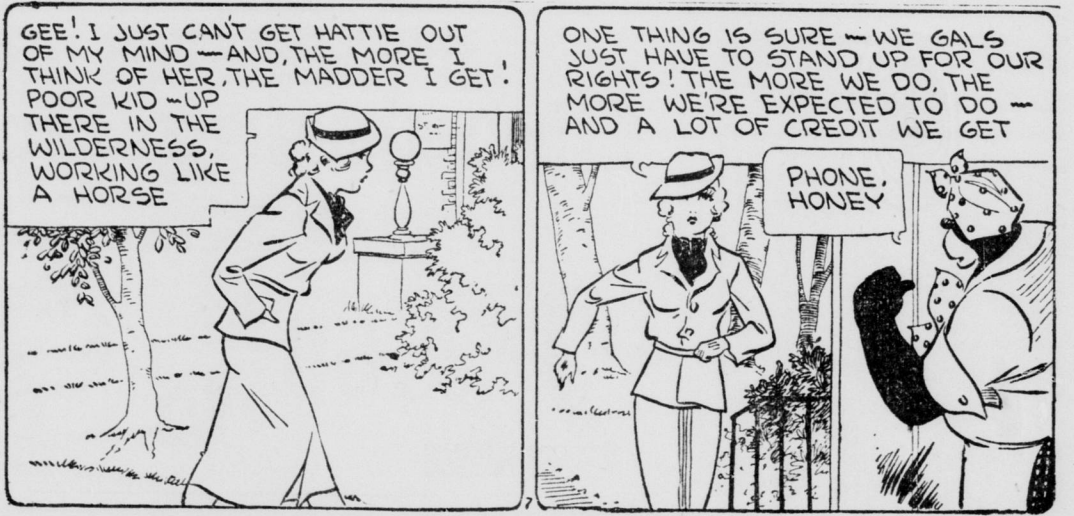

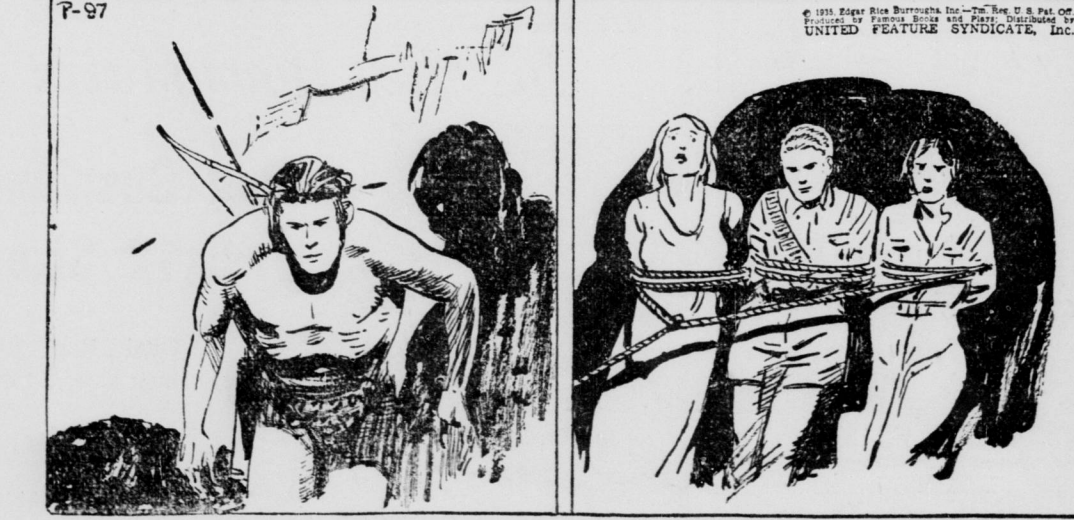

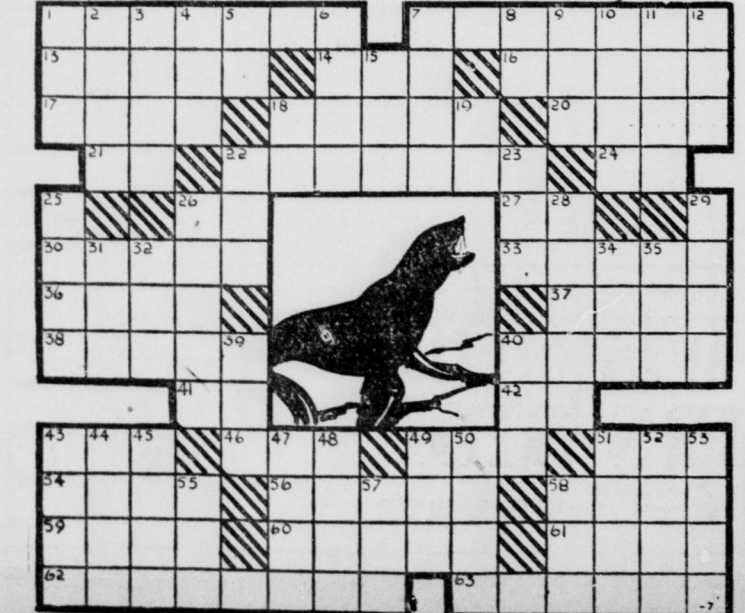
THIS CURIOUS WORLD By William Ferguson
