FACTORY CHIEF
IS DEAD AT 51Robert S. Montgomery Rites
Are to Be Held Here
Tomorrow at 3.

Funeral services for Robert S. Montgomery, 51, for the last year and a half manager of the Indianapolis plant of the Chevrolet Commercial Body Corp., are to be held at 3 tomorrow at the Flanner & Buchanan Mortuary. Dr. J. Ambrose Dunkel of Tabernacle Presbyterian Church is to conduct the services. Cremation is to follow.

Mr. Montgomery died yesterday after an illness of a year. A native of Rochester, he was graduated from Purdue. For 12 years he had been employed by Chevrolet. Previously he had been identified with the Du Pont company. He was a Mason.

Surviving are the widow; his mother, Mrs. Alla Montgomery, Long Beach, Cal.; two brothers, Guy Montgomery, Los Angeles, and O. W. Montgomery, Chicago, and a son, Robert Montgomery, Indianapolis.

Paul Rudicel Dead

Last rites are to be held at 1 tomorrow afternoon for Paul Rudicel, 28, former student at Indiana University and the Indiana and Benjamin Harrison Law Schools who died yesterday at his home after an illness of five years. He was a patient for two years at the Sunny-side Sanitarium.

A native of Wilkinson, Mr. Rudicel was graduated from the Wilkinson High School. He studied at Indiana University for a year and then took up law, lacking six weeks of completing the course when taken ill.

He is survived by the widow, Mrs. Grace Rudicel; his father, Ross Rudicel, and a brother, Charles Rudicel, all of Indianapolis.

Mrs. Ella Lewis Dies

ITALIAN PHYSICIAN IS
ACQUITTED IN LONDONTropical Diseases Authority Faced
Professional Charges.By United Press
LONDON, Nov. 29.—Sir Aldo Castellani, famous Italian expert on tropical diseases, has been acquitted by the British General Medical Council of charges of unprofessional conduct. It was announced today. The nature of the charges was not revealed.

The case was heard at a two-day secret meeting of the council. It was announced that the charges did not concern Castellani's Italian activities. He recently was appointed chief medical inspector of the Italian forces in East Africa. Castellani, knighted by King George in 1928, maintains his offices in London.






