

DIES ANNOUNCES MOVE TO CLEAR U. S. OF ALIENS

Congressman Pushes Plan
He Claims Will End
Unemployment.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 13.—A congressional drive to clear the country of aliens as a means of solving the unemployment problem was announced today by Representative Martin Dies (D., Tex.), who said he would file a petition to force a House vote in January on his program.

He estimated more than 8,000,000 alien workers now are in the United States. His bill would stop all new immigration, deport all aliens illegally in America and all aliens legally here who refuse to become citizens.

"I believe on the basis of a broad investigation I have made that three-fourths of our unemployment problem can be traced to the alien situation," Mr. Dies said. "The number of aliens who should be deported total three-fourths of the 11,000,000 jobless."

Mr. Dies has been campaigning for years to cut down immigration. He has led House fights in this field constantly.

6,206,000 Aliens Here

"My bill would permit only a 40 per cent exemption from present quotas for the sole purpose of reuniting families," he said. "There now are 6,206,000 aliens in this country exclusive of those illegally here. They should be required either to become citizens in a reasonable time or be deported."

"One can only guess at the number of those illegally here. There are only 800 men to protect our borders. Last year 17 airplanes used in smuggling aliens were captured. There also is widespread evidence of deserting seamen. Any alien who wants to come in here illegally can do so because of racketeers and our long borders."

"Also recall that \$300,000,000 a year is sent back to their homelands by aliens in this country. We can solve the unemployment problem in this way alone and I intend to call on the Administration to take a definite stand in this respect."

CAMBRIDGE, Mass., Dec. 13.—Definite scientific evidence of how the human ear determines pitch was presented before the Acoustical Society of America meeting here by Prof. Hallowell Davis, Dr. S. Stevens and Dr. Moses H. Lurie of Harvard University.

Different parts of the basilar membrane in the ear, they have experimentally determined, are selectively tuned to vibrate in response to sounds of different pitch. Theories holding this to be the basis of our recognition of pitch have been advanced before, but the work of these three scientists presents definite verification.
