AUDIT OF FUND SHOWS INCOME OF \$742,982

\$670,861.66 Expended by Welfare Agency; \$82,457 Collected for '36.

Receipts of the Indianapolis Community Fund for its fiscal year ended Oct. 31, 1935, totaled \$742,982.24 with disbursements for the same period being \$670,861.66, according to an audited report by George S. Oliver & Co., public accountants.

The total receipts and balance item of \$742,982.24 includes payment of 1936 campaign subscriptions amounting to \$2,457. The audited report follows:
