

OIL MEN LEAVE FOR HOMES AS MEETING ENDS

'Petroleum Marketing Code' Lauded by Head of Gaseteria Corp.

Delegates to the spring convention of the Indiana Independent Petroleum Association, Inc., departed for their homes today after the two-day meeting at the Severin.

As a departing message, Russell S. Williams of the local Gaseteria Corp., spoke on the "Petroleum Marketing Code," in which he explained the purpose and operation of a voluntary code now being placed before industry over the nation.

According to Mr. Williams, the majority of independent operators in the Central Western states have endorsed the code as it was drafted by a committee selected from all branches of the industry meeting in Chicago recently.

Code Would Stop Price Wars

The purpose of the code, Mr. Williams said, is to meet the need for market stabilization, which in turn would stabilize prices and eliminate gasoline price wars. A special need for a nation-wide adoption of the code, according to Mr. Williams, is because of increases in taxes and operating costs.

After the proposed code has been presented before associations in all states, the committee intends to

place it before the Federal Trade Commission for indorsement. Officials of the state organization intimated here yesterday that even if the code were not adopted nationally, associations in nine Midwestern states would operate under its regulations.

Other Speakers Named

Other speakers on yesterday's program were Richard Mills, local attorney, who spoke on "Current Problems," and E. J. Gallmeyer, representing the Wayne Co. of Fort Wayne, who talked on "Merchandising at the Island."

Other convention addresses were delivered by L. J. Scheidt, president, Col. T. Russ Hill, nationally known sales authority, and L. L. Schoemaker, of Dayton, O. The annual banquet was held Wednesday night.
