TRACK PROJECT  
APPLICATION TO  
BE FILED SOON

Mayor Kern Reports Capital WPA Officials Favor  
\$3,000,000 Work.

Application for a \$3,000,000 South Side track elevation project may be filed with the Works Progress Administration by the end of next week, it was indicated at the Weiss Board meeting today.

Mayor Kern said that he learned in Washington that funds might be obtained under an amendment to the deficiency bill and that WPA officials indicated they favored the project.

He said that John R. McCarl, Federal Controller-General, who turned down a previous request, might raise the objection that Federal funds should not be used on private property.

Application blanks are to be sent to Wayne Coy, regional WPA director, Monday, and City Engineer Henry B. Steeg said it was possible to fill them out by the end of next week.

The application must be indorsed by Mr. Coy, the Department of Agriculture's bureau of roads and the State Highway Commission, Mayor Kern explained.

HOUSE BODY REACHES  
ACCORD ON TAX POINTForeign Firms, Stockholders With  
U. S. Income to Pay Levy.By United Press  
WASHINGTON, March 20.—Congressional tax experts were disclosed today to have reached a tentative agreement under which the Federal government would seek to collect millions of dollars in taxes on foreign corporations and shareholders.

The House Ways and Means Subcommittee reached a tentative agreement to withdraw 33 1/3 per cent in dividend payments by American corporations to foreign shareholders, pending tax collection. The subcommittee also agreed to adopt a flat rate of 22 1/2 per cent on net income of foreign corporations doing business in this country.

THREE DENY CHARGE  
OF STILL POSSESSIONTwo in Federal Court Plead Guilty  
to Embezzlement, Perjury Charges.

Herschell Musgrave, former Indianapolis policeman; John E. Arvin and James E. Surface, pleaded not guilty in Federal Court today to possessing an unregistered still.

Frederick J. Whicker, farm superintendent for the Federal Joint Stock Land Bank, pleaded guilty to embezzeling \$7800. Sentence is to be passed tomorrow morning.

Harry Trimble, Indianapolis, pleaded guilty to perjury in connection with the falsification of bail bond records and is to be sentenced tomorrow, also.

Two men indicted in connection with the alleged Muncie "hot car" ring, Steve Ringley and Wilbur G. Caldwell, pleaded not guilty. They were charged with violation of the Dyer Act.

COUNTERFEIT GANG IS  
GIVEN PRISON TERMSAlleged Leader Sentenced to 10  
Years by Judge Baltzell.

Jack O'Day, alleged leader of a counterfeit gang that passed bogus 50-cent pieces in Indianapolis, was sentenced to 10 years in the Federal prison at Atlanta, Ga., today by Federal Judge Robert C. Baltzell.

O'Day and Dewey Dyer, his wife, Cordelia Dyer, and Henry Whitlock, Negro, all pleaded guilty to counterfeiting charges as persons indicted by the Federal grand jury were arraigned.

Dyer received three years, his wife a year and a day, and Whitlock 90 days.

John Isaac McClelland, former teller at the Fletcher Trust Co., pleaded guilty to embezzlement charges and was fined \$200 and sentenced to two years.

TEACHER WINS \$7500  
IN MOTOR COACH SUITHobart Chenoweth Awarded Dam-  
ages by Jury.Times Special  
NOBLESVILLE, Ind., March 20.—A jury returned a verdict today giving Hobart Chenoweth a judgment for \$7500 against the Peoples Motor Coach Co. of Indianapolis for injuries alleged to have been sustained more than a year ago when a bus of the defendant company crashed into the plaintiff's car.

The case was venued here from Marion County. Chenoweth has been a teacher at Technical High School, Indianapolis, for many years.
