

## 1983 YOUTHS OF MARION COUNTY HELPED BY NYA

847 of These Are Furthering Their Education With This Aid.

One thousand nine hundred eighty-three young persons, residents of Marion County, are furthering their education or contributing to the family income through jobs provided by the National Youth Administration in Indiana. Edward E. Edwards, state director, said today.

The report continues: Out of school and unemployed, 1136 of these youth have been engaged on work projects in recreation, rural, public service and research activities; 504 boys and girls are being assisted to attend school through high school aid projects, and 343 Marion County youths are earning part of their expenses in colleges and universities throughout the state.

Youths between the ages of 16 and 25 years are participating in the program of the National Youth Administration. Relief status is required for employment on work projects, but not for receipt of high school or college aid.

Earns Up to \$25 Monthly

Six hundred ninety-five young men and 441 young women are employed on the work projects 42 hours a month, earning from \$19 to \$25, depending upon their labor classification. On high school aid projects 217 boys and 287 girls are earning up to \$6 a month.

Through college and university projects 205 young men and 138 young women are earning part of their college expenses. In addition, 170 nonresident students are attending Marion County colleges with NYA assistance. Sums earned do not exceed an average of \$15 a month. Colleges participating include Arthur Jordan Conservatory of Music, Butler University, Indiana Central College, Indiana Law School, Indiana University Extension Division, Indianapolis College of Pharmacy, John Herron Art School, and N. A. G. U.

A government and land survey of Marion County is being sponsored by Charles A. Grossart, county auditor, under the rural work project classification. Data is being gathered for the state planning board bearing on the land use situation, such as tract ownership, assessed valuation, tax delinquent lands, roads, streams and other information.
