

LODGE TO GET CHARTER DATED BACK 81 YEARS

High Masonic Officials to
Attend Presentation Here
Monday.

The Hon. Robert H. McKinney, Covington, the Most Illustrious Grand Master of the Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters of Indiana, is to visit Indianapolis Council No. 2, Royal and Select Masters, Monday at 7:30 at the Masonic Temple. He is to present the council with a charter of authority dated July 16, 1855, the date of the original charter presented to the council. It is expected that Mr. McKinney will be accompanied by other grand council officers and distinguished visitors from other states.

This will be a unique occasion in the history of Indianapolis Masonry, because Council No. 2, although active in the Grand Council of Indiana, has never had a charter issued to it by that body.

A. Ross Manly, illustrious master of the Indianapolis Council, is expected to make the occasion of this presentation an open meeting to which all members of the Masonic fraternity will be invited. Besides Mr. Manly, Indianapolis Council officers are Carl F. Gierke, deputy master; Alden Davis, principal conductor of work; Edward F. Monn, P. I. M., treasurer; John N. Cullum, recorder; George F. H. Schreiber, captain of the guard; Frederick Manker, conductor of council; Clarence Ganner, steward; Henry St. Clair, P. I. M., sentinel; Frank Nutting, P. I. M., chaplain; and John H. Carroll, P. I. M., representative to the Masonic Relief Board.

SHEPPARD EXPLAINS JOB INSURANCE BILL

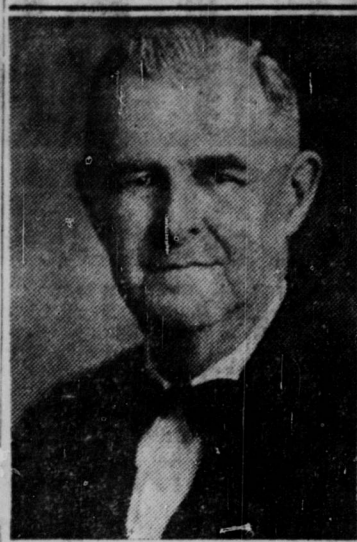
Main Objective, to Stabilize Work,
C. of C. Expert Says.

"One of the main objectives of the state unemployment compensation act is to stabilize employment," according to Virgil Sheppard, Chamber of Commerce government expert. He spoke yesterday before the Indiana Motor Traffic Association at the Antlers.

Reviewing the act in its relation to the trucking industry, Mr. Sheppard stated that only employees of firms subject to the act will draw the benefits from it.

"Persons unemployed now will not benefit until they become employed in private industry and are then laid off because of lack of work for them to do."

COURT AWARDS SECURITY CLAIM TO BOND OWNER

Decision Is Second of Week
Involving La Grange
Trust Co.

The Appellate Court has ordered the La Grange Circuit Court to award Mrs. Baba Bogue of La Grange a judgment of \$2348 against the defunct La Grange County Trust Co.

The decision was made on the appeal of Mrs. Bogue to make her claim of \$2300, plus interest, preferred in liquidation of the bank. The lower court held that only part of the claim was preferred.

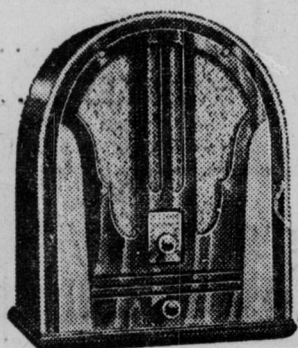
According to evidence, Mrs. Bogue turned over a \$100 government bond to be sold and reinvested in Federal Land Bank certificates. Soon after the transaction, the bank closed and she did not receive the certificates, she charged.

A similar decision involving the La Grange bank was handed down by the court this week. It also established a preferred claim of a depositor. Rollo N. Walter, former State Senator and secretary of the bank, was indicted and served 11 months in the state prison on a charge growing out of the Bogue bond transaction.

Walter was freed on one indictment and appeal on the second count is pending before the Supreme Court.
