

CARLOS McNEILL, LILLY PLOTTER, SEEKING PAROLE

U. S. Justice Department
Studies Appeal Backed by
Rep. Greenwood.

WASHINGTON, April 9.—The Justice Department Board of Review today considered a pardon appeal for Carlos McNeill, 24-year-old former Indiana University student serving a five-year term at the Chillicothe (O.) reformatory for extortion.

Rep. Arthur Greenwood appeared before the board to urge a parole for McNeill, who with James Woods, McNeill's chum in Paragon, Ind., pleaded guilty to sending an extortion letter to Eli Lilly Jr., Indianapolis capitalist. Both recently were denied paroles.

Since McNeill is from Paragon in Morgan County, his mother came here and enlisted her congressman, Rep. Greenwood, to aid in the fight for her son's freedom. The youth's father is a Newcastle physician.

\$25,000 Demanded in Note

Mr. Lilly received a letter April 27, 1934, demanding payment of \$25,000 on the threat of kidnapping himself or members of his family. He was ordered to place the money in a bag and board a train May 1 from Indianapolis to Vincennes. When he saw a white flag tied to a tree, he was to throw off the sack of money.

Working with Federal agents and Detective Morris Corbin of the Indianapolis Police Department, Mr. Lilly followed instructions, except that money was not placed in the parcel.

McNeill and Woods were traced through the flag, which originally had advertised a revival service at a country church, and the type-writer used to write the threatening letter.

Wanted Money for Marriage

After authorities had checked specimens of typing on almost all of the machines in Morgan County, they learned that a man lent his typewriter to the two youths. The specimens checked.

The youths pleaded guilty on June 27, 1934, and were sentenced by Federal Judge Robert C. Baltzell. District Attorney Val Nolan has op-

posed granting of paroles to McNeill and Woods.

The youths told the judge that they had been unable to find jobs after they left college, and one said he wanted the money to finance his proposed marriage.

Office-Seeking Clergyman
Rallies Independents.

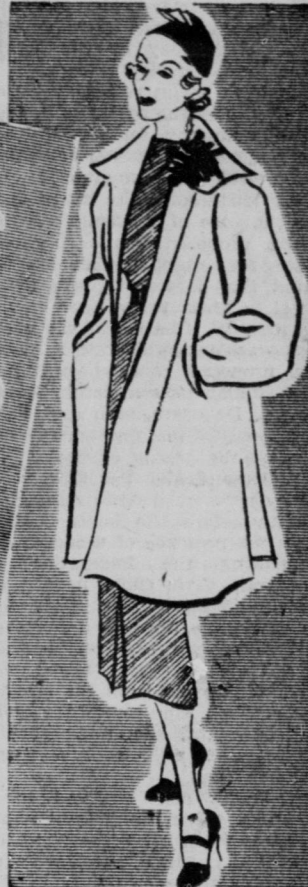
