

## SMITH OPPOSES SECURITY ACT'S CENTRALIZATION

Administration Should Be  
Left With Communities,  
Attorney Says.

"Regardless of the manner of financing the Social Security Act in Indiana there is no excuse for further centralization of administrative powers," Leo X. Smith, attorney for the county and Township Officials Association, said today.

Contending that administration of funds should be left to the community whose taxpayers furnish the money, Mr. Smith commended the present law, but criticized suggestions of centralization growing out of hearings on tax proposals before a special joint legislative committee.

The committee, appointed to work out a plan to finance the security program without increasing property taxes, adjourned last night after a preliminary two-day session. The group will convene again after Sept. 1, when it expects to get definite information about what the program will cost.

### Renewal of Fight Hinted

Mr. Smith's statement came as a reply to Edward P. Brennan, state budget director, who explained the state naturally would insist on complete authority if it took over the entire cost of the security program.

Renewal of the home rule fight between state administration and county and township officials was suggested when Mr. Smith said the organization he represented had defeated previous moves to centralize social security authority and would continue its fight.

A proposed \$4 per capita tax would, it has been said, raise between \$5,000,000 and \$6,500,000. Both Mr. Brennan and Mr. Smith agree that this estimate is too high.

### Other States' Practices

Other states, according to Mr. Smith, have adopted taxes on gasoline, horse racing, alcohol, sales, gross income inheritance and property to finance social security legislation.

Mr. Smith contends that administration of funds collected in the county should be left to county and township officials.

"Even if they should decide on a gasoline tax," he continued, "the money would come from the communities where it will be spent. People who pay the money should have authority when it comes to spending it."

The County and Township Officials organization was strongly opposed to all previous moves to delegate authority in state boards and directors while legislation was being considered.
