

PLAYGROUNDS ARE TO OPEN IN CITY ON JUNE 15

Little Eagle Creek Site Only
New Addition to
System.

Thirty-eight playgrounds opening on June 15 are to be operated here this summer by the Park Board. H. W. Middsworth, city recreation director, has announced.

The Little Eagle Creek Park playground, now in the process of construction, is the only addition to the system. As previously announced, playgrounds at Pleasant Run-blvd and Orange-st and Ray and Wyoming-sts are not to be opened.

Playgrounds to be supervised by the board:

Belmont, at Belmont-av and White River; Brookside, 16th and Dearborn-sts; Brightwood, Roosevelt and Olney-sts; Christian, English-av and Denny-st; Camp Sullivan (white), New York and West-sts; Camp Sullivan (Negro), New York and West-sts; Cornelius and 40th-sts; George-av, Washington 30th and Dearborn-sts; Douglas (Negro), 25th-st and Martindale-av; Elberberger, Michigan-st and Pleasant Run-blvd; Finch, State and Fletcher-av; Fall Creek, Fall Creek-blvd and College-av; 49th and Arsenal, 49th-st and Arsenal-av.

Greer-st, Greer and McCarty-sts; Golden Hill, south of 30th-st and west of Northwestern-av; Garfield, Southern-av and Shelby-st; Haw-thorne, Belleview-av and Washington-st; Highland, Marlowe and New York-st; Hill, 1305 Columbia-av; Oak Hill, Lawrence and Roosevelt-av; Indiana, Washington and Elder-sts.




