

\$2406.03 SPENT BY SHERIFF RAY IN MAY PRIMARY

Lists \$500 Donation From
Paul Rochford; Others
File Statements.

Expenditures of \$2406.03 for the primary election are shown in the expense statement of Sheriff Ray on file today in the bureau of election office. He was the successful Democratic candidate for renomination.

His statement lists contributions of a like amount, including a \$500 donation from Paul Rochford, \$400 from Anna Ray and \$250 from Helen Hofstetter.

Doyle W. Vorhees, commissioner from the Third District, spent \$412.50 in his campaign for renomination. Dr. John E. Wytenbach, candidate for coroner, listed disbursements of \$302.08.

Other Expenses Listed

Other Democratic candidates who listed their campaign expenses are: Darrel C. Walton, for surveyor, \$65; Lawrence C. Miller, for State Representative, \$84; Leroy Porteus for State Senator, \$311; Prosecutor Herbert M. Spencer, \$700, in the form of a contribution to the county committee; Harry F. Hobart, for county commissioner from the Third District, \$224.

Commissioner John S. Newhouse from the First District, who was renominated, \$298.75; Louis W. Heagy for Representative in Congress from the Twelfth District, \$64; Walter F. Jones for Representative in Congress from the Eleventh District, \$940; James J. McCaslin for State Representative, \$1424.

Ernest C. Ropkey for State Representative, \$111; James N. Wallace for Representative in Congress from the Eleventh District, \$197.08; Edward C. Wakeman for State Representative, \$150, and Jacob Weiss for State Senator, \$179.61, and the Weiss for Senator Club, \$235.50 with contributions of \$240.
