

## PAROLES DENIED LOCAL CONVICTS IN REFORMATORY

Three Refused Leniency as  
State Board Frees  
Fourth Man.

A parole petition of Alfred Linne, who is serving a 15-year sentence in the Indiana State Reformatory for alleged participation in a series of holdups of Indianapolis bus drivers, today had been denied by the State Clemency Commission. Linne was sentenced in 1933.

Acting yesterday, the commission also denied a parole plea of Victor Benjamin, sentenced to 10 years from Marion County in 1933 for alleged participation in the robbery of an Indianapolis home.

William Scott, who was sentenced in Marion Criminal Court in 1931 to 10 years for burglary, was granted parole. James Leech, serving a 10-year term imposed in 1931 for automobile banditry, was granted a commutation of sentence, making his term six to 10 years.

Lawson Jacks, another local prisoner, serving 10 years for robbery, was denied a parole. He was sentenced in 1932. James W. Bayes, sentenced here in 1932 to 10 years for robbery, was paroled to Michigan authorities, who wanted him for parole violation.

The Clemency Commission granted a total of nine commutations of sentence and eight paroles and denied 25 petitions.

Process Made Millionaire  
of Paris Hairdresser.

NEW YORK, June 4.—Marcel, retired Parisian hairdresser and inventor of the hair waving process bearing his name, died Tuesday night at his Chateau de Thiel in France, it was announced today. He was 84 and had lived the last 39 years of his life as a gentleman farmer. His invention of the Marcel wave at the end of the nineteenth century made him a millionaire.

Born the son of a stone mason, Marcel rose to international fame. After retiring from the hairdressing business in 1897 he was hailed like a king wherever he traveled.

200,000 EARN LIVING  
ON ROQUEFORT CHEESE  
Manufacture Is Chief Industry of  
French Village.

ROQUEFORT, France, June 4.—More than 200,000 pounds of Roquefort cheese are manufactured annually in this picturesque French village. For more than 11 centuries this cheese has been manufactured on a commercial basis, but Roquefort cheese, itself, goes back even farther in history. It is mentioned by Pliny the Elder, who wrote in the early decades of the Christian era.

More than 200,000 persons, working on 35,000 farms, are employed and earn their living directly from the cheese industry. Milk is contributed by 700,000 sheep, tended by 10,000 shepherds.
