

## DOCTOR WARNS ILLNESS COSTLY

Increased Pay Profitable  
From Health Standpoint,  
Convention Told.

SOUTH BEND, Ind., Oct. 7.—Increased wages to enable workers to choose their own doctor rather than a system of politically controlled "socialized medicine" were urged by Dr. R. L. Sennich, South Bend.

in his presidential address before the Indiana State Medical Association today.

"Sickness, and especially disabling diseases, are much more frequent in the low-income group than in those of better financial status," Dr. Sennich said.

"Repeated illness of employees is costly to business manufacturers. It must be recognized that the individual whose living conditions are unfavorable to health, lives and works at a less effective level than the individual who lives under more healthful physical and psychological conditions."

"A man can not give a dollar's worth of work if his physical condition is capable of only 50-cent production," the association head declared.

"This group is not so large and

it is probable that controlling these losses might go a long way toward meeting the costs of the moderate wage increases necessary to make better living conditions possible for the very low income group."

"It also might be reflected in diminished sickness dependency in public institutions which constitute a considerable tax burden."

FORT WAYNE, Ind., Oct. 7.—A wage increase which will mean an estimated additional \$175,000 in the annual pay roll has been announced by executives of the Fort Wayne plant of the General Electric Co.

The 6700 employees are to receive immediately a 2 per cent wage increase under the new automatic wage adjustment plan adopted by the company. The plan will be governed by the relative cost of living as set forth in the index published quarterly by the Department of Labor, plant officials said.
