

WELFARE CLASS WILL HEAR COY

First of Lecture Series
Sponsored by I. U.
Scheduled Tonight.

A series of nine weekly discussions on the Federal Social Security and Indiana welfare acts is to open at 8:10 o'clock tonight in the Y. W. C. A. auditorium.

The auspices of Indiana University are to be held every Wednesday night. Provisions have been made for welfare workers and sociology students to attend. Admittance cards are being issued at the Indiana University Extension offices. Wayne Coy, State Public Welfare director, is to open the discussions tonight with an address on "The Social Security Program." The second lecture, scheduled next Wednesday night, is to be given by Dr. Hoard B. Mettel, Maternal and Child Health Bureau chief. He is to discuss the "Public Health Program under the Security Act."

FARM IMPORTS HELD U. S. NEED

Agriculture Is Dependent on
Foreign Exchanges,
Conference Told.

LAFAYETTE, Ind., Oct. 7.—"American agriculture in its present status is still dependent upon an export market," declared Dr. O. B. Jesness, University of Minnesota economics department head, at the annual ex-

tension workers conference at Purdue University yesterday. "The question is," Dr. Jesness said, "are we going to recover any or all those foreign markets or are we going to curtail our agriculture permanently?" "It is hard for me to see that small imports such as we have in the case of butter and other commodities are undesirable to the American farmer," he said. "We trade because we specialize. We can't believe in specialization and not trade as the two are the Siamese twins of economics. It's inescapable that we must let some imports enter this country if we are going to export." Dr. Jesness today was to continue his discussion on foreign markets for agriculture, and H. M. Dixon, United States Department of Agriculture, was to speak on "Why Local

HEBER HICKS' TRIAL IS SET FOR DEC. 3

BROOKVILLE, Ind., Oct. 7.—Trial of Heber Hicks, chauffeur indicted in the slaying last June of Harry Miller, retired Cincinnati (O.) fire captain, has been set for Dec. 3. Prosecutor Kenneth Copes has announced. Although police said he confessed

being the "master mind" in the plot to kill Capt. Miller, Hicks is expected to plead not guilty. A \$3000 reward has been posted by Miss Flora Miller, Cincinnati, sister of the victim, for capture of John Pohlsky, William Kuhlman and Frank Williams, all of Cincinnati, on the basis of Hicks' reported confession.
