

TWO PER CENT CLUB ATTACKED

Springer Declares McNutt Imposes Unofficial Tax on State Workers.

HUNTINGBURG, Ind., Oct. 7. — After comparing Gov. McNutt to Stalin, Hitler and Mussolini, Raymond S. Springer, Republican gubernatorial candidate, declared at a party rally here last night that the state government now is moving

"in the direction of collectivism." "The question in this campaign is whether the government of Indiana shall be given back to the people, or whether it shall be allowed to continue its present course," he said. Mr. Springer said the Governor "has time and time again, by his personal actions, and his official policies, declared 'I am the State.'" Attacking the "Two Per Cent Club" as an insult to the Democratic Party, the Republican candidate said: "Never before had a Governor of Indiana even intimated that an extra-legal tax should be levied on the income of all those employed by the state. Never before had a Governor taken the position that he was more important than the party that honored him by nomination and election. What the money collected by

the McNutt levy on all state employees is used for, no state employee dares to ask," he said. Mr. Springer charged that Gov. McNutt had circumvented the state Constitution, which forbids a Governor from succeeding himself, by "compelling nomination of a man through whom he can act as Governor by proxy."

VanNuys Defends U. S. Spending

Expenditures of the Roosevelt Administration were defended by

United States Senator Frederick VanNuys at a meeting of the Statehouse Women's Democratic Club last night at the Indianapolis Athletic Club. The Senator said 55 per cent of national recovery was due to government spending and denied that future generations would bear heavy tax burdens as a result. "These vast sums have been spent to help agriculture, to save homes and farms, to keep railroads, banks and insurance companies going and to repair the human damage incident to the worst panic in our history," Senator VanNuys said. "Relief has cost the government approximately seven and one-half billion dollars, but it has directly

and indirectly given 25,000,000 destitute people food, clothing, shelter and work and saved this country from the terrorism which now threatens all Europe." The Senator said that had it not been for the payment of the soldiers' bonus and the invalidating of the AAA processing taxes, the new revenue act of 1936 would not have been needed. "The act of 1936 raised inheritance and gift taxes upon large estates and increased surtaxes on personal incomes over \$50,000. These increases affected only one out of every 6000 citizens of the country," Senator VanNuys said. "The purpose of this act was to reach those capitalists who permitted enormous corporate profits

to pile up in order to avoid paying individual surtaxes on dividends." **Speakers Announced by Democrats** Senator Joseph T.
