

'STREAMLINED' SCHOOL SYSTEM HERE OUTLINED

Stetson Hints Possibility of Junior College With Technical Courses.

The Indianapolis school system is to be "streamlined" to meet 1937 requirements, according to Supt. Paul C. Stetson. He announced a committee of 75 senior high school teachers to study needs for the coming year.

He spoke yesterday at an all-city high school teachers meeting in the Caleb Mills Hall, Shortridge High School.

The possibility of a Junior Technical College with vocational institutes and creative institutes for special students, was outlined by Mr. Stetson. Present courses are to be enlarged instead of adding more courses to the school curriculum, he said.

The relation of general and special educational courses, the need for secondary school reorganization, study of social problems, encouragement of creative ability and the place of the school in relation to morals and manners were included in Mr. Stetson's discussion.

Mr. Stetson warned against educational "fads" which he termed "forced and highly artificial."

School work must be organized toward one objective, "development of pupil personality," he said. He suggested the phrase "extracurricular activity" be eliminated from the school vocabulary.

Vocational institutes, he said, could aid older groups forced by economic pressure to remain in school until their 18th year. The pendulum has been toward specialization, but is now turning toward general knowledge, he pointed out.

"We will undertake no more important work during the next two or three years than this revision of curriculum," Mr. Stetson said. "Its effects will touch the lives of thousands of secondary school pupils."

Junior high school reorganization work was started in 1931 and now virtually is completed. High school curricula has never been revised, he said.

Further Improvements Await Irvington Grant

The public school building program is to be expanded to include improvements on Technical, Broad Ripple and Crispus Attucks High Schools if the \$202,500 PWA project for a new Irvington High School is approved, according to A. B. Good, School Board business director.

The application has been approved, but allocation of funds awaits Congressional action on continuance of the PWA beyond June 30.
