Marion County's traffic death toll for 1937 rose to 18 today as the name of Mrs. Evelyn Mattingly Collins was added to the list.

Mrs. Collins, who died yesterday in Methodist Hospital, was struck by one of two cars which collided at Addison and Ohio Sts., Dec. 29. She lived at 250 N. Addison St. She was 32.

Harry Wilson, 46, of 235 N. Temple Ave., was reported in serious condition at City Hospital today from injuries received last night when he was struck by an automobile while alighting from a streetcar. He has a possible skull fracture, hospital officials said.

**Driver Arrested**

Police arrested William Dushane, 335 N. Sherman Drive, on charges of leaving the scene of an accident and passing a streetcar which was discharging passengers.

The accident occurred at Temple and Washington Sts.

Police said the auto said to have been driven by Dushane struck the rear of the streetcar, then hit Mr. Wilson and finally struck a telephone pole.

## \$18,000 PAID FOR ALCOHOL VIOLATIONS

More than \$18,000 was collected by the State for violations of the alcoholic beverages act during the period from June 1, 1935, to Jan. 1, 1937, Ray Hinkle, chief of the Excise Department enforcement division, reported today.

The largest item was \$6657.90 for additional seating capacity for which permittees had not paid license fees. A total of \$5523 was voluntarily paid by permittees for law violations and \$3218.67 was collected from the sale of illegal liquor, Mr. Hinkle said.

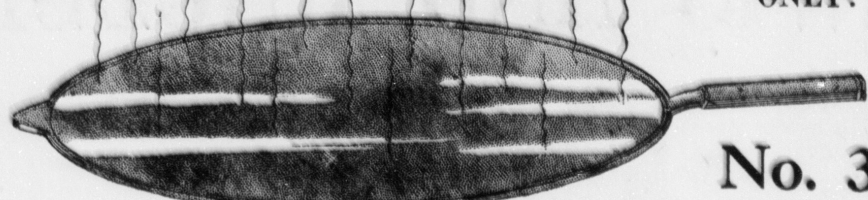

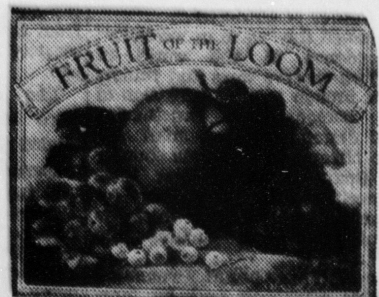
