

**U. S. COMMERCE
AID TO JOIN IN
LEGION'S DRIVE**

Annual Aerial Roundup Set
To Start on May 2,
Officials Announce.

J. Monroe Johnson, Assistant Secretary of Commerce, is to participate in the fifth annual National Aerial Membership Roundup of the American Legion May 2, it was announced today.

Mr. Johnson, Air Commerce Bureau head, is to speak at the annual dinner to be given that night for visiting pilots by Harry Colmery, Legion National Commander.

Other outstanding aviation personages invited include Commander Charles E. Rosendahl, of the Lakehurst, N. J. Naval air station and former commander of the ill-fated Shenandoah.

Howard Hughes Expected

Another is Howard Hughes, holder of speed records.

More than 100 planes are due here on the day the Legion makes its annual collection of membership cards. Hop-offs of planes have been scheduled so that they will arrive at Municipal Airport between noon and 4 p.m.

Legion officials say that reports indicate the planes will bring in more than the 50,000 membership cards landed here on the 1936 roundup day. The cards are expected to boost the membership past the 900,000 mark.
