

## SLEEP-WALKER BRUISED IN FALL FROM WINDOW

Man Who Had Been III  
Plunges 20 Feet; Two Die  
In Accidents.

Oscar Singer, 62, of 1428 S. New Jersey St., escaped serious injury early today when he fell 20 feet from a second-story window in his home.

Hospital physicians said they were told Mr. Singer had been walking in his sleep. His wife, Maude, told police he had been ill for seven weeks.

Mr. Singer was treated at City Hospital for head lacerations and body bruises.

Giles Miskel, 52, of Route 4, Box 679, was in St. Francis Hospital today with serious injuries received in a fall from a farm roller when a team of horses bolted.

Funeral arrangements were to be completed today for Forest Wysong, 1130 Cottage Ave., fatally injured when he fell down the basement stairs in a tavern at 1109 Shelby St. last night. He was 60.

Police said witnesses told them Mr. Wysong entered the tavern, paused momentarily at the bar and then started down the stairs. They said he fell about half way down the flight of steps. He received a fractured skull.

Henry Adams, Terre Haute, died in City Hospital today from injuries received yesterday when he fell beneath the wheels of a Pennsylvania train in West Indianapolis. He was 65.


Police were told that Mr. Adams was attempting to board the train which was leaving for Terre Haute. His legs were amputated when he slipped under the wheels. It was reported.

### NAPS BESIDE STOVE; SUFFERS FOOT BURN


