

LAW OFFICIALS PUSH TRAFFIC SAFETY DRIVE

**Ignorance of Law Is Main
Cause for Increasing Toll,
Stiver Says.**

School authorities, State Police and law officers today co-operated with Governor Townsend and the State Highway Department in a campaign to check Indiana's rapidly mounting automobile accident death toll.

Indicating that one of the main causes of accidents is ignorance of the law, Donald M. Stiver, State Safety Director, pointed out that the list of victims of automobile accidents in Indiana is at present far ahead of the same period last year. The safety campaign proceeded today along three fronts—enforcement, education and engineering. Acting on a statement by Governor Townsend, Mr. Stiver has ordered arrests for all violations of the law.

Prison Terms Advocated

"For the adults who decline to accept censure and education in the simple rules of safety, I recommend special schooling behind prison bars," Governor Townsend said. In connection with the educational program communities began safety courses in schools and safety council activities which included lectures and accident prevention literature.

State Highway Department engineers studied methods of eliminating dangerous curves, obstructed views and other traffic hazards.

Some of the main laws outlined in the campaign to acquaint drivers with highway regulations include:

1. Speed limit of 20 miles an hour on public highways in closely built-up business sections of any city, town or village, and 30 miles an hour on public highways in residence sections of any city, town or village.
2. Dimming of bright lights when approaching another vehicle coming from the opposite direction. Use of spotlights forbidden except for reading intersecting highway signs or house numbers or by truck and bus drivers to light the highway to the right of the traveled portion.

Passing Requires Caution

3. Passing of other vehicles traveling in the same direction is unlawful unless the motorist desiring to pass has a clear and unobstructed view ahead for 500 feet and there is no other vehicle coming from the opposite direction within 500 feet.
4. Motorists approaching pedestrians on the traveled part of the highway or any intersecting highway, curve or corner where the view is obstructed must slow down and sound the horn or bell.

5. All motor vehicles operating on the public highways shall have good and adequate brakes in good working order and sufficient to control the vehicle at all times when in use.
6. Passing of school-bus while school children are alighting is unlawful.

be punished by a fine of from \$10 to \$50 and imprisonment from 10 days to six months and loss of driving privilege for not more than a year.

For a second or subsequent drunken driving offense, the penalty shall be imprisonment from one to five years and loss of driving privilege for a year. No drunken driving penalties may be suspended by the judge.

8. A report of all arrests for safety law violations shall be made to the State Motor Vehicle Commissioner, where the report will be made a matter of record, under terms of a law passed by the 1937 Legislature.

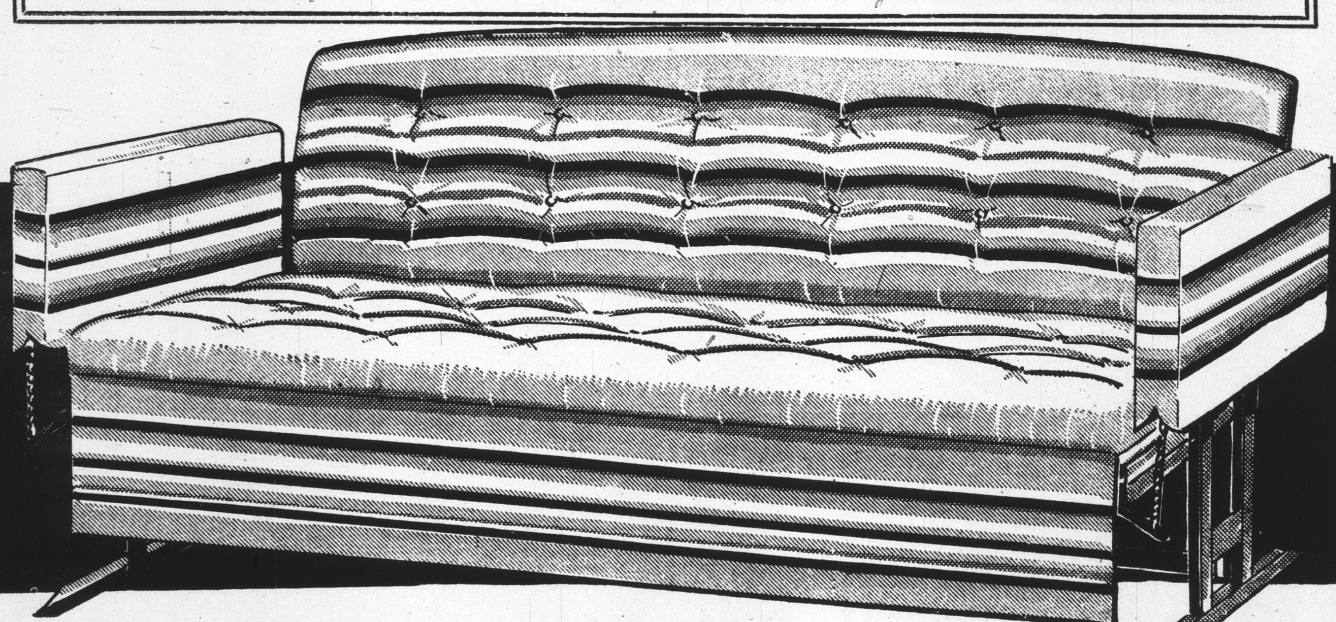

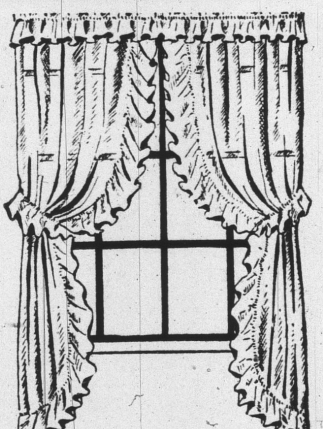
