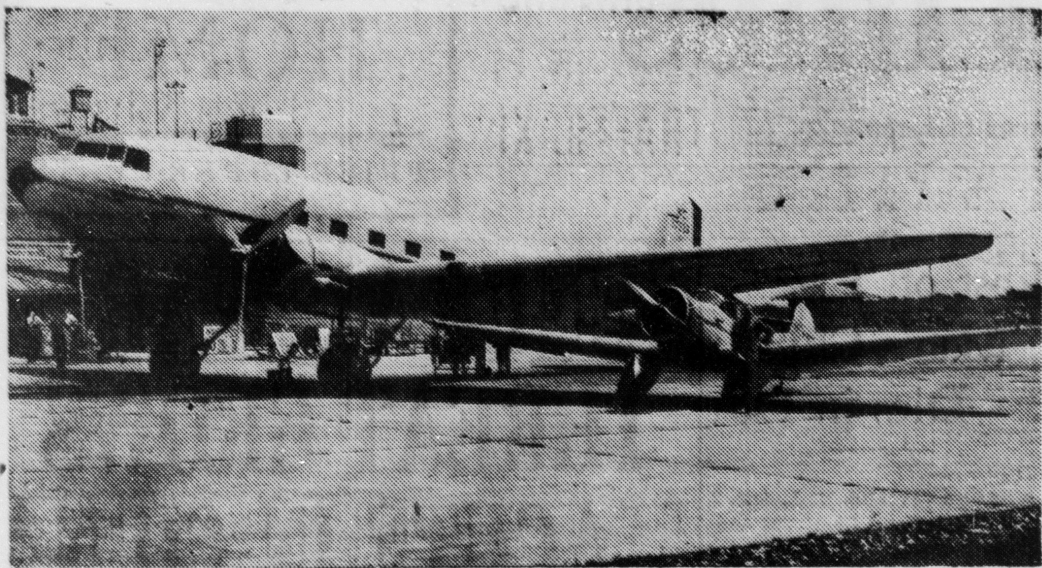

U. S. SPENDING REPORT ISSUED

Expenditures Since 1930
Twice Federal Income,
League Aid Says.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 2.—The National Economy League estimated today that the Federal Government must reduce expenditures by \$1,600,000,000 to \$3,200,000,000 per year before it can balance the budget and start reducing the national debt.

John C. Gebhart, league director, made public a survey of Federal finances covering what he described as the "seven lean years" of deficits. He said that if the contingent guaranteed debt of \$4,718,000,000 were added to the direct public debt of \$36,425,000,000 on June 30, the national indebtedness would be found to have reached "the staggering total of \$41,143,000,000."

The survey claimed that since Dec. 31, 1930, when the national debt stood at \$16,026,000,000, Treasury receipts have totaled \$23,602,000,000 while expenditures amounted to \$45,634,000,000.

"During that period," Mr. Gebhart said, "we have spent about two dollars for every dollar taken in. We have increased the public debt until it is now two and a quarter times as large as it was in 1930; it is \$10,000,000,000 higher than the peak of the war debt."

He estimated that if receipts are as high this year as Treasury officials predict they will still fail to cover expenditures by \$1,600,000,000 and that if they prove to be no higher than last year's they will still lack \$3,200,000,000 of expenditures.

I. U. OFFICIALS AND STUDENTS TO CONFER

Discussions on Courses Are To Be Held Here.

YOUTH OFFICE HELPS 7000 YOUNG PEOPLE

Nearly 7000 young men and women were served by the junior placement division of the National Youth Administration in the Indiana State Employment Service office during the year ending May 31.

Of 6988 individuals served, 4641 were new applicants. Jobs were found for 1596 youths. Vocational guidance was given all applicants, and more than 11,000 interviews were conducted.
