

## CANDIDATES FOR I. U. PRESIDENCY TO MEET BOARD

Trustees Set Sept. 13 for  
Interviews With 25  
Educators.


The Indiana University Trustees are to meet in Bloomington on Sept. 13 to interview candidates for the presidency left open by the resignation of Dr. William Low Bryan, it was announced today.

The Board met here yesterday afternoon and reduced to about 25 the list of more than 100 names of educators proposed for the position. George Ball, Muncie, board president, was unable to attend.

Board members said they still are "open to suggestion" of additional names. Judge Ora L. Wildermuth, Gary, who presided, said "every effort will be made to agree upon a selection as early as possible during the academic year."

It was reported the consideration of candidates was the only business taken up by the Board.

## Bridge Work Rushed for Spring Traffic



Four shifts of 160 WPA workers—100 during the day and 60 at night—are being used six days a week to rush to completion the Shelby St. bridge over Pleasant Run, Marion County WPA officials announced today. The project is approximately 40 percent completed.

Started a year ago the structure is expected to be

completed early next spring. WPA officials said the reinforced concrete arch type of bridge was required because of the unusual amount of heavy traffic that will pass over the structure, including the double tracks of the Indianapolis street railway system. Shelby St. also is the only arterial street leading out of Indianapolis to the southeastern part of the state.




