

YOUTH INDICTED FOR 'JEALOUSY KILLING' OF GIRL

Death Penalty to Be Asked For Richmond Boy After Jury Action.

RICHMOND, Ind., Sept. 10 (U.P.)—Hollys Sagerer, 16-year-old sandlot baseball star, today faced first-degree murder charge for the alleged "puppy love" slaying of pretty, brunet Martha Markey.

The youth, who allegedly shot his 15-year-old schoolgirl sweetheart because she was going to have another "date," was indicted by the Wayne County Grand Jury last night. Judge G. H. Hoelscher said he probably would be arraigned today or tomorrow.

Prosecutor John Britten indicated he would ask for the death penalty. Indiana law does not lessen the sentence in the case of a minor.

According to local police, Sagerer shot Martha while she sat on the front porch of her home talking with two girl friends. The boy had appeared at the house earlier that day to ask her for a "date," authorities claimed. When she didn't answer, but did Murial Hill, told Hollys she had decided to go out with another boy, they charged.

Claims Gun Borrowed

Sagerer, enraged, went to the home of Ray Kinder Jr., borrowed a rifle on a pretext of going squirrel hunting, the authorities claimed.

He obtained some shells at his own home, then, with Kinder, took his father's car and drove to the rear of Martha's house, according to officers. They said Kinder was ignorant of Sagerer's plan.

In a signed statement, police claimed Hollys said he found Martha with two other girls on the porch, that he walked up, shot the girl in the head then drove Kinder home.

Martha died in Reid Memorial Hospital. The bullet had entered the back of her head and lodged behind her left eye.

Sagerer returned to the Markey home and was arrested. Later he told police he tried to shoot himself but the gun jammed, they said.

Martha was to have entered Morton High School Thursday. Sagerer was a sophomore.

Arch Morton, 1131 Gimbel St., commander of Veterans of Foreign Wars Post No. 908, charged with violation of the Anti-Slot Machine Law, is to appear in Municipal Court again next Friday. His case was continued yesterday by Judge Charles Karabell.

German-American Bund Members Called Foes of Americanization Efforts

Yearbook of Society Described as Written From Nazi Code; Chicago Newspaper Continues Alleged Expose of Group.

CHICAGO, Sept. 10 (U.P.)—American Nazis make "health, Hitler, hell and hatred" the 4-Hs of their drive to "prevent Americanization of American children." Nazis are members of the German-American Bund," the Chicago Times said today.

Today's copyrighted installment of a series based on a six-month under-cover investigation, said the Bund yearbook was reprinted from the German magazine Deutsche Arbeit.

Referring to German children who have emigrated to America, the yearbook said, according to the Chicago Times:

"In the coming year, all the unity and the efforts will be required in order to put a stop to the former crippling by the Americanization of their young."

The paper charged 20,000 Bund members were preparing to seize control of the United States when Communists and Jews—as Nazis expect—start a revolution.

John Metcalfe, a Chicago Times investigator, quoted Alfons Brem, member of the Astoria, Long Island Bund Post, as saying:

"We feel that one of these days the U. S. must make its choice between communism and fascism. When that day comes—and no one knows how soon—we must be prepared. We do not advocate a revolution, but we rear there is apt to be one, when the revolution comes, we will be prepared to defend it. Then we shall rise to fight it. We shall go on the side of fascism. We do not believe in racial equality—that Negroes and Jews are as good as white men."

Another investigator reported one Bund youth camp was at the Deutschhorst Country Club, near Croydon, Pa., and 40 boys and 25 girls live there in tents.

Indianapolis Groups Doubt Nazi Story

Indianapolis German-Americans said today they knew nothing of plans to form a Nazi organization here, as the Chicago Times reported in a copyrighted story.

Leaders of local German social societies said they did not believe the report and would oppose such an attempt.




