

MAROTT ASKS BOETCHER FOR CLEAN SEWERS

Forget Downtown Coliseum
And Clean Fall Creek,
He Asks Mayor.

(Editorial, Page 10)

George J. Marott, Indianapolis shoe store and hotel owner, today asked Mayor Boetcher to "give us a clean sewerage system and a clean waterway and forget a downtown coliseum at this time."

In a letter to the Mayor, Mr. Marott termed the present system "deficient" and suggested that the State Fair Grounds coliseum be heated as a substitute for a new municipal building.

He suggested that Fall Creek be cleared and made fit for boating through the use of Government funds.

Urges Creek Use

The text of Mr. Marott's letter follows:
"I notice in the newspapers, you recognize the inefficiency of the sewer system and it is your purpose to give prompt attention to this very important service to the health of the people and the welfare of our good city."

"It is a shame that our Fall Creek waterway is contaminated by combination sewage that often, particularly in the summer, has an unbearable stench along the waterway, which makes plain the necessity of clearing this Creek from such a nuisance and give us a waterway that would be a credit to the city and a pleasure for boating. I believe more than a million dollars is spent every summer by our citizens vacationing at lakes and other waterways when they might enjoy the waterway of Fall Creek with White River."

"Our Government has been most liberal in relieving such conditions in other cities at much Government expense, and what is more valuable to Indianapolis than to accept the Government's assistance on this most deficient sewer system?"

Puts Sewers First

"I believe comparatively all thinking citizens of Indianapolis but a few would say, 'Give us a clean sewer system and a clean waterway and forget a downtown coliseum with a hotel at this time.' If we must have a coliseum, why not the State Fair Grounds coliseum, fitted with a heating system with added seating capacity in the bowl of the coliseum. I feel certain it would be ample for any needs. A great advantage in the location is the fact that the railroad service is directly to the place and no coliseum should be built without a track connection for delivery of utilities and other things important in promoting commercial enterprise as well as politics. Taxpayers know they are burdened, hence it is time to forget unnecessary expenditures."

"I wish to congratulate you on your prompt attention as Mayor to the consideration of this important situation, and wishing you every success and support."

Buford Cadle, State Northwest Territories Commissioner, today announced that the commission is preparing to accept applications from men to participate in the caravan which is to leave Ipswich, Mass., next December.

"The caravan is to travel the road followed by pioneers who settled the Northwest Territory," Mr. Cadle explained. An eight-episode historical pageant is to be presented in cities along the route. Training is to start Nov. 1. Men are to be provided with meals, lodging and \$1 a day and a \$100 bonus for those who make the entire trip.
