

# STANDARD MARK FOR NO-PASSING ZONES DECREED

Yellow Circles Will Notify  
Drivers to Stay  
In Line.

All State highway engineers have been instructed to standardize the marking of "no-passing" zones on Indiana roads, Earl Crawford, State Highway Commission chairman, reported today.

The last Legislature passed an act requiring establishment of these zones wherever motorists do not have a minimum of 750 feet sight distance ahead.

A yellow circle, 24 inches in diameter, will notify motorists they are entering a "no-passing" zone. A yellow line will parallel the black center line on curves and hills where there is limited vision. Motorists must remain in that traffic lane as long as the yellow stripe is on either side of the center line.

Goodan contended the Internal Revenue Commissioner erred in including in the taxable estate real estate valued by the Government at \$6,000,000.

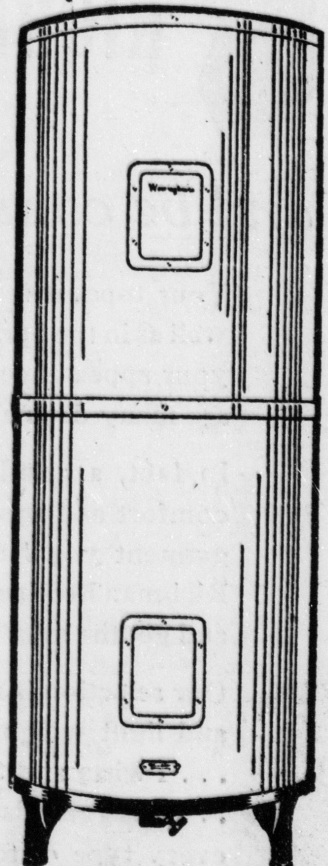

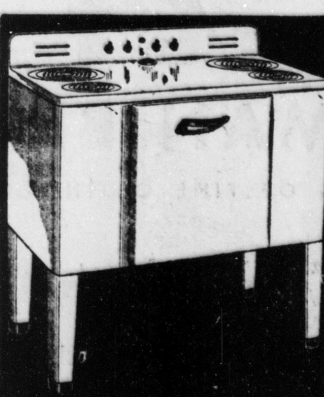
