

## JOHNSON LED HALL OF FAME

Served as Ambassador to Italy During Wilson Administration.

NEW YORK, Oct. 15 (U.P.)—Funeral services will be held Sunday for Robert Underwood Johnson, 84, poet, editor, director of the Hall of Fame at New York University and former Ambassador to Italy, who died at his home yesterday after a long illness.

Mr. Johnson, frequently called the unofficial poet laureate of the United States — many of his odes and sonnets were written spontaneously in honor of some outstanding personage, to praise an outstanding achievement—wrote his last poem three weeks ago. "Muir at Yosemite," dedicated to John Muir, co-founder with him of the movement which resulted in the creation of Yosemite National Park.

The genial, white-bearded poet was born in Washington Jan. 12, 1853, on that part of Capitol Hill now occupied by the House of Representatives Office Building. He spent his boyhood at Centerville. In 1876 he graduated from Earlham College. In 1876 he married Miss Katherine McMahon of Washington, who died Dec. 31, 1924. Their son, Owen Johnson, is the author of "Stover at Yale" and many other books.

### Edited Century Magazine

As editor of Century Magazine, Mr. Johnson became an intimate friend of Grant S. Grant, Mark Twain, Thomas Nelson Page, Joel Chandler Harris, Helen Hunt Jackson and Richard Watson Gilder.

President Wilson appointed him ambassador to Italy in 1921. He remained in Rome until July, 1921.

Mr. Johnson was one of the founders of the American Academy of Arts and Letters, displayed great activity as director of the Hall of Fame at New York University and was one of the leading spirits in the fight for an international copyright law.

Besides the son, he is survived by a daughter, Mrs. Frank H. Holden of New York, who was at his bedside when he died; a brother, Henry Underwood Johnson of Richmond, Ind.; six grandchildren and four great-grandchildren. Burial will be at Stockbridge, Mass.

### OFFICIALS CONFER ON INDIANA PARKS



### STATE PROSECUTORS WILL CONVENE HERE

Discussion of Criminal Laws Is Scheduled.

Prosecuting attorneys of various Indiana counties are to discuss methods to tighten criminal law enforcement at a two-day conference to be called by Attorney General Ormer S. Jackson late in November or in early December.

Under an act of the 1937 Legislature, such conferences are required at least once a year.
