ZUPPKE'S NEPHEW WITH ILLINI
INDIANA MADE SLIGHT CHOICE

INDIANA'S home-coming game with Illinois at Bloomington tomorrow will be in the nature of career anniversaries for popular sports figures—Coach Bob Zuppke of the "Fightin' Illini" and Trainer Jesse Ferguson of the "Fightin' Hoosiers." . . . Zuppke is celebrating his 25th year as coach of the Illini and Ferguson has just completed 25 years of service as athletic trainer, and he also has had service as track coach and swimming mentor. . . . The Illini squad practiced at Champaign this morning and will reach Indianapolis late this afternoon on a special train.

Only players and the football staff will ride the special. . . . They will remain here over night and go to Bloomington tomorrow morning. . . . Kickoff time is 2 p.m.

COACH ZUPPKE'S nephew, Robert E. Zuppke of Minneapolis, is on the Illini squad. . . . He's a third-string end, weighs 195 and stands 6 feet 2 inches. . . . Young Zuppke is a sophomore and looks the part of a comer, according to reports from Champaign. . . . Indiana hasn't won a game from Illinois since 1903, when Zora G. Clevenger, athletics director, was captain of the Hoosiers. . . . The score was 17-0.

Bo McMillin's warriors were heartened by their fine showing against Minnesota and the Illini stock soared as a result of the scoreless tie with Notre Dame. . . . The prediction of the writer is for a close one at Bloomington tomorrow with Indiana the winner.

BUTLER plays its second home game tomorrow and is the choice by a wide margin over Evansville. . . .
