

HOOSIER TEAM SECOND IN 4-H U. S. CONTEST

2 Union County Youths Will
Receive \$250 Cash
Scholarships.

LAFAYETTE, Oct. 15.—Indiana's champion 4-H dairy demonstration team from Union County, which won the title at the Purdue 4-H Roundup last June, was runnerup in the national contest this week at the National Dairy Show at Columbus, Ohio.

The team, composed of Eugene Thomas, 16, and John Carson, 17, was coached by O. V. Winks, Union County agricultural agent. Each will receive a \$250 cash college or university scholarship. Thirty-six states were represented in the national contest.

Cattle Judgers 14th

The state's champion dairy cattle judging team, selected at the Indiana State Fair 4-H judging contest, placed 14th. A Nebraska team carried off top honors. The Indiana team was from Decatur County and was coached by A. W. McCrackin, vocational agriculture teacher.

John Stewart, member of the Indiana judging team, was the high individual in judging Guernsey cattle. He received a gold medal from the National Dairy Show.

Two graduates of the Purdue School of Agriculture have accepted new positions, according to Prof. J. J. Davis, head of the entomology department.

John M. Amos, Lafayette, has been named research entomologist with the Delaware Agricultural Experiment Station.

D. W. LaHue of Corydon has accepted a position with the U. S. Bureau of Entomology in Lafayette.




