

## LEARNS COUPLE WANTED HERE IS IN CUSTODY

Boetcher Is Told Florida  
Officers Are Holding  
Young Pair.

Donald E. Young and his divorced wife, Elsie Mae Young, under indictment here in connection with an alleged \$61000 swindle, are in custody at Tallahassee, Fla., awaiting delivery to Marion County authorities. Mayor Boetcher was informed today in a telephone call from Sheriff Frank Stoutamire, Tallahassee.

The couple was arrested. Mayor Boetcher was informed after Prosecutor Herbert M. Spencer charged Governor Cone of Florida of "legal delay" in releasing the fugitives to Marion County authorities. They had been free under bond following previous capture.

Mayor Boetcher was told by Sheriff Stoutamire that the Youngs' attorney had agreed to withhold for five days further legal action seeking to block their return to Marion County. It was explained further legal steps might be embarrassing to the Governor.

Mr. Spencer immediately attempted to reach his attaches who had gone to Florida and were en route to Indianapolis after the futile trip. He hoped to intercept them at the Ohio River bridge at Louisville and order them to return to Florida and receive the fugitives.

Meanwhile, Governor Townsend received a telegram from Governor Cone condemning Mr. Spencer's charges of "legal delay" and defending action of the State of Florida.

Deputy sheriffs, meanwhile were to open a safety box rented by Young. A writ to attach the contents of the box in a downtown bank was granted in Superior Court 1 yesterday for attorneys for a man and woman, alleged victims of the swindle.

Governor Cone also wired Mr. Spencer regrets for the legal delay.

**Writ Is Denied**

The Governor's wire read: "I believe your agents will confirm the statement that this office has co-operated fully and expeditiously on your request for extradition of Donald Young and Elsie Mae Young."

"The hearing which is customary in all states was granted immediately after which your requisition was granted and sheriff of this county authorized to take fugitives

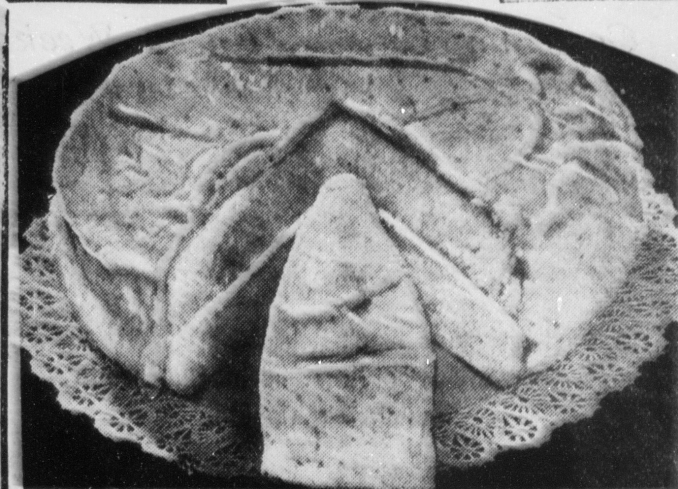

I think something should be done, but I haven't got a remedy. The process of impeachment is one of the most antique and cumbersome practices still in use."
