

LEARNS COUPLE WANTED HERE IS IN CUSTODY

Boetcher Is Told Florida
Officers Are Holding
Young Pair.

Donald E. Young and his divorced wife, Elsie Mae Young, under indictment here in connection with an alleged \$600 swindle, are in custody at Tallahassee, Fla., awaiting delivery to Marion County authorities. Mayor Boetcher was informed today in a telephone call from Sheriff Frank Stoutamire, Tallahassee.

The couple was arrested. Mayor Boetcher was informed, after Prose.

Herbert M. Johnson, charged Governor Cone of Florida of "legal delay" in releasing the fugitives to Marion County authorities. They had been free under bond following previous capture.


