

HENRY C. ATKINS TO BE HONORED AT 'Y' BANQUET

Trustees, Directors to Pay
Tribute to His 36 Years
With Organization.

Henry C. Atkins Sr., president of E. C. Atkins & Co., is to be honored by the Indianapolis Y. M. C. A. boards of trustees and directors at a dinner tomorrow night for his 36 years of service with the organization.

Mr. Atkins was elected a director in January, 1902, and the following year was named vice president of the association. In 1906 he became treasurer, serving in that position until this year, when he resigned. He continued, however, as a director.

Mr. Atkins also has been chairman of the industrial committee for two years.

During Mr. Atkins' period of service, Y. M. C. A. activities have been extended widely in Indianapolis. The present central building was constructed and a branch established for Negro members.

JUDGE TAKES HINT FROM HIGH COURT
LOS ANGELES, March 31 (U. P.).—Municipal Judge Joseph Call was eating lunch and reading a newspaper. He saw where Chief Justice Charles Evans Hughes had held in a Supreme Court decision that a hangbill ordinance in Griffin, Ga., violated guarantees of freedom of the press.

Judge Call returned to his courtroom, dismissed the case of Miss Melba Strand, who was charged with violation of a city ordinance in passing out handbills in front of an auditorium where Mrs. Franklin D. Roosevelt was speaking.

Fugitive Cat Is Object of Police 'Search'

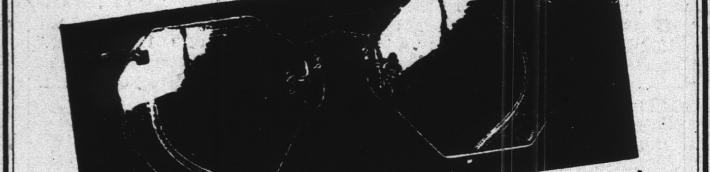

Legislation which would authorize Mayor Boeticher to name a five-man authority has been pending before Council for some time.

HUNTINGTON VETOES HEAT UTILITY PLANS

HUNTINGTON, March 31 (U. P.).—Mayor Clare W. H. Bangs received another setback last night when the City Council voted down his proposal that Huntington go into the heating business.

By a vote of 4 to 2 the Council indefinitely suspended ordinances to

combine the City waterworks with the municipally-owned light plant and establish a steam-heating utility.

Under Mayor Bangs' ordinances an Indianapolis firm would be employed to engineer the heating of a

\$374,000 bond issue of which \$300,000 would be placed against the water-

works and the remainder applied on the steam-heating plant.
