

FUND TRANSFER IS RULED LEGAL

\$150,000 Now Available for
Administration of Relief
In Indiana.

Transfer of \$150,000 from the funds of the Governor's Commission on Unemployment relief to the State Department of Public Welfare for the temporary administration of Indiana's relief program was ruled legal today by Atty. Gen. Omer Stokes Jackson.

The ruling enables the Department of Public Welfare to continue the distribution of Federal surplus commodities to the needy and the certification of persons for relief and for WPA and NYA jobs by drawing on an appropriation made to the Governor's Commission in 1933.

The Governor's Commission shifted relief administration to the Welfare Department when the Commission's administrative funds were exhausted Oct. 1, Welfare Department officials said.

Commission Has 2 Million

By a legal technicality, the Commission with about \$2,000,000 at its disposal "for the purpose of relieving hardship resulting from unemployment," cannot expend any part of that money for administrative purposes.

It had been operating principally on an allotment of Federal funds, and a small State administrative Commission on Unemployment Re-approvement which officials said had authority to authorize the

was insufficient without the Federal money.

In a resolution approved by the Governor last June, the Commission declared that an emergency existed for the expenditure of funds necessary to carry on the administration of its program.

"It is my opinion," the Attorney General said, "that the Governor's General should have the administration of relief until an appropriation is made by the 1938 Legislature.

BUILDING ASKED AT SCHOOL 19

Board Accepts Award for
No. 91 Structure at 51st
And Baltimore.

A School Board committee today was prepared to investigate reports that a portable building is needed at School 19 and that more land will be required for the expansion. Mrs. Eleanor Wooley, 959 Brook St., who represented the school's Parent-Teacher Association, told the Board that because of crowded conditions, the portable was needed for the home economics class. She added that the school grounds apparently were not large enough for the proposed portable. The Board announced that a new

grade school building would be built at 51st St. and Baltimore Ave., and that plans for it were approved. The new school will be No. 91.

Also adopted was a resolution accepting a Federal grant not to exceed \$106,000 to aid in the construction of another grade school. The site for this school has not yet been selected, A. B. Good, schools business director said.

Low bid of \$101,298 submitted by the Hempell Noyes Co., Chicago, for the sale of bonds at 2 per cent interest to aid in financing the construction of a new building at Tech High Schools was accepted by the Board.

Bids for construction work necessary for the completion of the Tech building were received and a committee was appointed to study and select the winning bid. The Board also gave permission in the form of a resolution to the WPA to demolish the old school building at School 11. Mr. Good explained that the building has been abandoned for some time and that it is no longer of any use to the Board.






