

COUNTY JUDGES TO STAND ASIDE ON LIQUOR TEST

High Court to Ponder Law
Changes on Briefs Filed
By Attorney General.

Marion County Superior Court judges announced today they will not file any pleadings in the Indiana Supreme Court case to test the constitutionality of the new state liquor law amendments.

The judges, defendants in the action, had been given until tomorrow to file an answer and briefs.

The test case brought 10 days ago on behalf of a Winslow beer wholesaler and the State Alcoholic Beverage Commission, asked the Supreme Court to restrain the Superior Court judges from hearing an appeal from a decision of the Beverage Commission. Such an appeal is provided under the recently passed amendments.

Time of Decision Uncertain

Chief Justice George L. Tremain of the Supreme Court said, in the absence of a Superior Court answer, the higher court will start deliberation of the case upon briefs submitted by the Attorney General's office. He did not indicate when a decision would be handed down.

The test case is based upon an appeal to Superior Court by a Petersburg dealer whose application for a beer wholesaler's permit was denied by the Beverage Commission. The Commission ruled that there now are sufficient dealers in that area to handle the business.

No Limit on Wholesalers

Under the new liquor law amendments, the limit on the number of beer wholesalers was removed.

Since the law became effective under an emergency clause during the recent session of the Legislature, 20 dealers have applied for wholesaler's permits.

Two new applications were filed yesterday by Buel E. Warren, Crawfordville, and James W. Atkinson, of Bicknell.

PLANTATION GAMING DEVICES STILL HELD

GREENFIELD, March 23 (U. P.).—Hancock County authorities today considered possible disposition of nearly \$20,000 in gambling equipment seized March 12 in a raid on the Plantation, night club, near here.

Ten men arrested during the club's opening night late yesterday paid fines totaling \$406.50 on gambling charges, but authorities had received no request to return the equipment to its owners.

The equipment must be held for a specified period before anything can be done with it, and Prosecutor Glenn T. Williams has asked for court authority to destroy it. However, it was understood that if owners of the Plantation asked for the property, it would be returned.

M'MURRAY TO ATTEND SCHOOL BUS MEETING

Floyd I. McMurray, State Superintendent of Public Instruction, said today he will attend a conference in Washington the next week in April to help draft uniform regulations for school busses.

The conference is sponsored by the U. S. General Board of Education "to set up uniform standards for busses."

Mr. McMurray said Indiana was one of the first states to establish uniform standards of safety in busses.

BABY DROWNS WHILE MOTHER IS IN COMA

TORONTO, Ontario, March 23 (U. P.).—Three-year-old Aubrey Ellison drowned in his bath here after knocking his mother, Mrs. Harry Ellison, unconscious.

Aubrey was jumping up and down in the tub. His head struck the mother's chin and she fell unconscious to the bathroom floor. When she regained consciousness the child was under water in the tub.

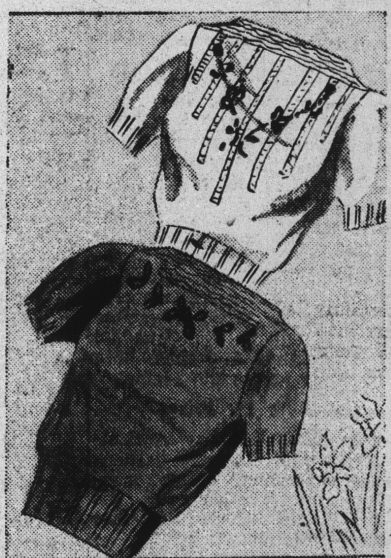
