

**STATE JOBLESS
GET \$20,350,000
AID DURING YEAR**

Changes in Law Take Effect
Tomorrow as Division
Has Anniversary.

The Indiana Unemployment Compensation Division will mark its first year of unemployment benefit payments tomorrow.

Amendments to the law will also become effective tomorrow. Clarence A. Jackson, division director said.

Mr. Jackson said 250,000 persons have claimed out-of-work benefits since April 1 last year, when claims for benefits could first be filed. Of these, 208,000 completed their waiting periods and have drawn checks for approximately \$20,350,000, he said.

The new amendments cut the waiting period for partial unemployment from four weeks to two weeks and eliminate the second waiting period.

The portion of contributions allocated to the employer's reserve account has been raised from five-sixths to 85 per cent, Mr. Jackson said. The balances required in the reserve account before contribution rates can be reduced in 1940 were reduced, and the penalty rate of 1 per cent, imposed on exhausted reserve accounts, was postponed until 1941.

Other amendments prohibit persons from drawing benefits if they are employed full time as commission salesmen and deny benefits to persons who quit their jobs voluntarily to marry, to enter self-employment or to those discharged for dishonesty in connection with their work.

**DETOURS LIFTED
ON FOUR ROADS**

State Highway Commission
Lists Seven Others Still
In Effect.

Four detours on Indiana roads were lifted by the State Highway Commission during the last week.

They were on Highway 13, north of Swayzee; Highway 39, north of Frankfort; Highway 58, east of Scottsburg, and Highway 49, at Stilesville.

Detours now in effect are:

Ind. 14—In Ft. Wayne.

Ind. 63—in South Bend.

Ind. 26—East of Fairmount, about 1½ miles over gravel and U. S. 35.

U. S. 35—From U. S. 6 west and north about 7½ miles over Roads 6 and 13.

Ind. 55—East of Newtown, about 5 miles over gravel and bituminous.

Ind. 145—From 1 mile north New Boston to Fulda, about 6½ miles over county gravel road.

Ind. 155—Southwest of Patriot, about 3½ miles over oil mat.

**PASTOR IS BARRED
IN CAPONE MIXUP**

SAN PEDRO, Cal., March 31 (U. S. A.)—The Rev. Silas A. Thweatt, who reported that Al Capone, his face seeming to "radiate," was among those Federal prisoners who indicated a need for prayer after the sermon Sunday, today had been barred from future prison services.

Warden E. J. Lloyd of the Terminal Island Prison said there was a strict rule against publicity concerning prisoners and asked the Harbor Region Ministerial Committee to drop the Rev. Mr. Thweatt from the list of those coming to the prison. The clergyman said the information about Capone became public through a chance remark.




