

## TOWNSEND NEAR U. S. 'AVERAGE' IN GOVERNORS

Three Years Older and Draws \$84 More Than Survey Example.

If Governor Townsend were three years younger, earned \$84 less a year and had not been born on a farm, Indiana would have the average American Governor, according to a survey completed today by the Council of State Governments.

The survey found that "the average governor is about 51 years of age, receives a yearly salary of \$7916, is a lawyer and a Democrat politically, is the father of three children and prepared himself for the job as chief executive by serving in the Legislature."

Indiana pays its chief executive \$8000 annually. While this is above the average at present, the survey found that in 1940 the national average will go up to \$8153.

Average Age Is 51

A study of Indiana's Governors since 1816, when Indiana came into the Union, show that the average age has been 51.

Twenty of the 34 Governors have been lawyers, three professional politicians, two editors, three teachers, two bankers and four, including Governor Townsend, farmers. The national survey found that the average Governor serves a four-year term or two-year term. In 24 states, the term is for four years, in 23 the term is two years, in one—New Jersey—the Governor serves for three years.

Can't Succeed Self

In Indiana the Chief Executive serves a four-year term and cannot succeed himself. In the past one Governor who advanced to that position through the resignation of the preceding governor served more than four years. The shortest term was in 1822 when the governor was chosen by the Legislature as U. S. Senator after being in office only three days.

26 Elected by People

Of Indiana's governors 26 have been elected by the people. Eight have been elected as Lieutenant Governor and become governor upon the death or resignation of their predecessor.

Twenty of the 34 governors attended college and 14 were born in towns and 20 in the country. While the majority of the governors have not been native Hoosiers, all those elected in the last 20 years have been born in Indiana.

Nineteen of the 34 have been Democrats, 12 have been Republicans and three were Whigs. In the last 50 years there have been nine "Republican" Governors and eight Democratic Governors.

Stassen Is Youngest

In the national study it was found that Governor Harold Stassen of Minnesota is the youngest chief executive. He is 33. Luren D. Dickinson, Michigan's Governor, is the oldest at 80.

Twelve Governors are 45 or under, 22 are between the ages of 46 and 55 and 14 are 56 or more years of age.


Governor Herbert H. Lehman of New York has been in office the longest. He has served three two-year terms and his present term is for four years.

## HEARING FOR BRIDGES TO START MONDAY

SAN FRANCISCO, July 7 (U. P.).—Dean James M. Landis of the Harvard law school was expected to arrive here today or tomorrow to preside at the deportation hearing Monday of Harry Bridges, West Coast leader of the C. I. O. The proceedings will be conducted at the immigration station on Angel Island. Bridges is accused of being "affiliated to or a member of an organization which teaches or advocates the overthrow of the American Government by force and violence."

The organization in this instance, the Government charged, is the Communist party.

## New Serum Saves Doctor From Death

KANSAS CITY, Mo., July 7 (U. P.).—An untried guinea pig anti-toxin for equine encephalitis today had saved the life of a prominent veterinary biologist, and his aids who developed the serum in desperation hoped they had found a remedy to save more human beings.

The serum restored Dr. Charles E. Salsbery, 57, to consciousness after he had lain 36 hours in a coma as result of contracting the dread horse sleeping sickness during experiments in his laboratory. As a last resort physicians had tried injecting anti-

toxin supplied from the blood of horses—the usual serum. But it produces shock in some humans, and Salsbery, his life ebbing, reacted unfavorably.

At his experiment laboratory, Dr. E. F. Sanders looked at the hundreds of long-suffering guinea pigs used in experiments and asked his associate: "Why not try guinea pig antitoxin?"

It hadn't been used on humans before, but it was known to Dr. Sanders' knowledge. Feverishly, he and four assistants worked through the night killing

100 guinea pigs that had built up antibodies, or immunity, to equine encephalitis. From the blood Dr. Sanders and his helpers prepared 100 cubic centimeters of serum and rushed to the hospital.

They injected five cubic centimeters of serum into the motionless patient.

Almost immediately he began to improve. Within a few hours his color was restored and he was talking to his physicians. He was a "mighty sick man" but a physician said he would live.

## NO TAX, NO LENIENCY FOR TRUCK RANCHER

SAN FRANCISCO, July 7 (U. P.).—Frank Mencavini, rancher, was before Federal Judge A. F. St. Sure accused of failing to pay tax on 870 gallons of wine.

"No vino, no laboro, no verdugo!" Mencavini said, which meant no wine, no work, no vegetables. He said he had to put a jug of wine at the end of each row to lure his workers through the bean and artichoke patch. Judge St. Sure was not impressed. He fined Mencavini \$100.
