

SCHOOLS READY FOR SPARE-TIME STUDENT RUSH

Two New Courses Opened
By Butler Evening Unit;
Teacher Added.

Schools giving Indianapolis citizens spare time study opportunities have prepared their fall semester programs and in some instances added new members to their faculties.

Two new courses have been added to the Butler University evening school in the College of Business Administration. Fraternal Life Insurance will be taught by J. Russell Townsend Jr. at 7:30 p. m. Tuesday nights, and Supervision of School Publications will be taught by William A. Evans, public schools director of publications, at 7 p. m. Thursday.

Twenty-four courses will be offered in divisions of journalism, economics and business administration.

Miss Thuemler on Faculty

The addition to the evening school faculty of Miss Gertrude Thuemler, dean of girls at Tech High School, also was announced.

Miss Thuemler will lecture on guidance, counselling and pupil personnel services. The three-hour course will deal with present trends in education which affect guidance services, the operation of the guidance program, present trends in the field of guidance and the theory and practice of pupil counselling.

Butler's 85th annual day school year will open tomorrow with registration of beginning students.

Freshmen week will be opened by addresses of President D. S. Robinson, Paul D. Hinkle, athletic director, and Prof. Clyde L. Clark, orientation activities chairman at 8:30 a. m. at the Field House.

At 9:15 a. m. deans of the colleges of liberal arts and sciences, religion, education and business administration will meet with beginning students. Freshmen are to meet with their sponsors at 10 a. m.

Physical Exams Thursday

Under the supervision of Prof. Sarah T. Slison of the English Department, English placement tests will be given at 11 a. m. Dr. Amos E. Carille of the college of education is to have charge of the college aptitude and adjustment tests to be given at 2 p. m.

Physical examinations will be given Thursday, as will try-outs for the University's band and choir. Members of the Y. M. C. A. and the Y. W. C. A. campus chapters will hold their annual freshman party at 8:30 p. m. in the gymnasium.

The Indiana University Extension Center has announced that Dr. Robert G. Stephens of the philosophy department will teach two subjects here. At 5:45 p. m. Wednesday he will teach the Field of Philosophy and at 8 p. m. the same day he will teach Philosophy of Art.

Dr. Stephens did his undergraduate and graduate work at Yale University, receiving his Ph. B. in 1931 and his Ph. D. in 1935.

Henry H. Remak, who was educated in Berlin and France, will teach German classes offered at the extension center this year. It has been announced. He has been a teaching assistant at I. U. for the last few years. His course will offer two sections of elementary German, one section of second-year composition and conversation, and a modern German prose course.

William W. Hene, an extension lecturer for the last three years, will conduct a German discussion group.

Registration for the Y. M. C. A. evening high school courses was open today and will be tomorrow. Work in these courses is designed for those who wish to finish high school requirements for college work and for those who wish to take courses to prepare them for advancement in their present positions.

Among the daytime schools, the Indiana Law School, 1348 N. Delaware St., will open its fall semester Monday with an enrollment. This school also will offer night classes Tuesdays and Thursdays.
