

GRIFFIN TO FACE TRIAL MARCH 25 IN RELIEF CASE

Motion to Quash Indictment Charging Fraud Is Overruled.

J. Barton Griffin, milk route operator indicted on a charge of filing false relief claims, is to go on trial March 25 in Criminal Court.

The date was set yesterday by Special Judge Omar O'Harrow, Martinsville, after he had overruled a motion to quash the indictment. John Neenan, former Center Township relief clerk jointly indicted with Griffin, will be tried at the same time.

Because any action in the Griffin case necessitates a special trip from Martinsville by Judge O'Harrow, the arraignment of Griffin also has been scheduled for the same day as the trial.

Neenan Pleads Guilty.

Neenan has pleaded guilty to one of four indictments against him. The Griffin-Neenan trial date is the second to be set in cases of five persons indicted several weeks ago following the Grand Jury's six-week Center Township relief probe.

Dan R. Anderson, grocer, is to go on trial March 4. He has pleaded not guilty to four indictments charging him with filing false relief claims.

Others indicted were Thomas M. Quinn Sr., former Center Township trustee, charged with bribery and official negligence; and Frank Bluestein, grocer, who has pleaded not guilty to filing false relief claims.

Reserves One Plea

Bluestein's trial probably will not be set until the other cases are tried. Quinn has pleaded guilty to the official negligence charge, reserving his plea in the bribery indictment.

The hearing upon which Judge O'Harrow made his ruling yesterday was held in Criminal Court more than three weeks ago. The motion to quash was filed only on behalf of Griffin.
