

FOREIGN POLICY DEBATE LOOMS

Stimson and Knox Hearings Will Open Tomorrow in Congress as Adjournment Becomes Issue; Army Expansion Plan Awaited.

WASHINGTON, July 1 (U.P.)—Congress reconvened today after a week recess to plunge again into multi-billion-dollar defense legislation and to begin what may become an historic debate of the Administration's foreign policy.

Major event of this week will be hearings by Senate committees on the nominations of Henry L. Stimson and Frank Knox to be Secretaries of War and Navy, respectively.

Although the nominations are expected to be confirmed, opponents will air the nominees' views on foreign policy and seek to make them an issue for full-dress debate on President Roosevelt's policy of "short of war" aid to the Allies.

Mr. Roosevelt's surprise Republican nominees will appear before Senate committees tomorrow—Stimson before the Senate Military Affairs Committee and Knox before the Naval Affairs Committee.

Wheeler Denounces Both

Senator Burton K. Wheeler (D. Mont.) opened the campaign against Knox and Stimson last night in Chicago. In a radio address at a mass meeting there he denounced both nominees as "war mongers" and said that if there must be a coalition cabinet, "let it be a coalition of peace makers—not war makers."

The important thing to remember is that both these gentlemen are publicly-avowed proponents of American intervention," said Wheeler, who has threatened to bolt his party if it becomes a "war party."

Major legislation confronting Congress is a bill authorizing 70 per cent expansion of the Navy at an estimated cost of \$4,000,000,000. Approved by the House, it is expected to be taken up by the Senate after action on a bill to revise the financial structure of the Hoover Dam.

Army Expansion Program Due

Later this week, President Roosevelt is expected to submit to Congress a program for the Army to match the Navy bill. It will authorize a long-range plan for mechanizing the Army. Preliminary unofficial estimates place its cost at \$5,000,000,000 or more.

As Congress reconvened there was a revival of talk about adjournment by Aug. 1. Such a plan will be opposed by a bi-partisan group that believes Congress should remain on the job throughout the international emergency.

No agreement on adjournment has been reached—a recess will be taken during the Democratic Convention beginning July 15—but party leaders believe that all pending legislation, including the Naval expansion and projected Army mechanization bills, the Logan-Walter bill and final action in the House on the Hatch "clean state politics" bill, can be accomplished by Aug. 1.

U. S. Corporations to Buy Rubber and Tin Reserves

WASHINGTON, July 1 (U.P.)—Federal Loan Administrator Jesse H. Jones today announced creation of two new corporations, financed in part by the Government, to purchase reserve supplies of rubber, tin and magnesium for the national defense.

The corporations are the Rubber Reserve Co. and the Metals Reserve Co., each with a capitalization of \$5,000,000—half of which is owned by the RFC and the other half by principal manufacturers in the rubber and metals fields.

STATE TO TAKE BIDS ON ROADS JULY 16

Bids will be received July 16 by the State Highway Department for the paving of 20 miles of state highways in seven counties at an estimated cost of \$670,000.

The projects include a dual lane pavement on Road 2 in La Porte and St. Joseph Counties; improvement of Roads 23 and 123 southwest of South Bend, and the paving of three sections of Road 31 in Scott and Jackson Counties. Other projects will be in Fulton, Clinton and Wabash Counties.






