

10 LOCAL TRUCK DRIVERS GIVEN FIRM'S AWARDS

Walter Hise Named 'Safest' For 260,000 Miles Without Mishap.

If you have trouble keeping your fenders straight, Walter Hise, 1437 Orange St., can give you some good tips. He has driven a truck 260,000 miles in six years with no accidents.

Mr. Hise has been awarded a gold pin and the title of "safest driver" by his employers, the Trans-American Freight Lines, for his safety record.

Of 140 "no accident" awards made by the company for records up to 1939, 10 were given to local drivers.

A five-year award was given to Forrest Money, 2442 Guilford Ave., who went from 1935 to 1939 without an accident while making an Indianapolis-Chicago run six days a week.

Other local winners are: Paul Maupin, 530 E. Terrace Ave., for four years of safe driving in Indianapolis; Tony Marshall, 6326 Pearson St., and Fred Marshall, R. R. 7, Box 438, three-year awards; George Houser, 2950 Shelby St.; H. V. Scotten, 714 E. Minnesota St., and Carl Zeller, 1704 Carrollton Ave., two-year prizes; and Charles McDowell, 910 E. 20th St., and Joseph Underwood, 1528 Shepard St., one year.

Urges Reduction in Taxes on Autos

An unusual rise in car ownership in Indiana has raised automobile taxes to the point where individual automobile taxes could be lowered, Leland K. Fishback, Indiana Petroleum Industries Committee secretary, said today.

Automobile ownership increased 20.7 per cent in Indiana from 1934 to 1938, Mr. Fishback said. Because most of the owners have incomes of less than \$30 a week, he said they have no great ability to pay present automobile taxes.

The burden of Federal and State automobile taxes absorbs from one to two weeks wages each year from a majority of the motorists in the state. A reduction in the tax burden would have the practical effect of giving to such motorists one or two days' pay each year, he said.

Gas Consumption, New Car Sales, Routings Up

Three indices of motoring popularity—gasoline consumption, new car sales and motor club routings—are at peak points, according to Todd Stoops, Hoosier Motor Club secretary-manager.

Gasoline consumption is running ahead of 1938, which was more than 35,000,000 gallons above the 1938 figure, an increase of 6.4 per cent.

"Practically every indicator at the beginning of the summer vacation season is bearing out the prediction made by the American Automobile Association the first of the year that all previous vacation records would be smashed during the current travel season," Mr. Stoops said.




