Rising French Politician Urges European Union Under Germany

PARIS, (Via Berlin), Oct. 31—

Jacques Doriot, head of the French Popular Party and widely regarded as a "romantic leader" of France, told the United Press in an interview that France should enter immediately an United States of Europe, led by Germany.

Outlining his views for the future internal organization of France, Doriot said France should form herself into a corporate state, in which

collaborate with them in such a

fraternal community of all classes without class dictatorship, should be established.

Doriot sharply criticized the United States and President Roosevelt and said that France should draw a lesson from the British attacks at Mers El Kebir (Oran) and Dakar, and follow a "clear-cut" policy towards England. To accomplish this, he said, France should seek immediately good relationships with all European powers.

Outlining his views for the future internal organization of France, Doriot said France should form herself

into a corporate state, in which

he would be instrumental in carrying it out.

"The new state," he said, "must be corporate to permit the association of all factors of production, the employers, the technicians and the workers, reunited in their enterprises and their corporate branches. The state will not permit the combination of international plutocracy and finance."

"It will be anti-liberal. It will be popular because it will reassemble the elite of the nation.

Doriot spoke of the rebirth of France in the tone of a man who

believed he would be instrumental in carrying it out.

"The new state," he said, "must be corporate to permit the association of all factors of production, the employers, the technicians and the workers, reunited in their enterprises and their corporate branches. The state will not permit the combination of international plutocracy and finance."

"He gave his program for eliminating unemployment, which he said was the most trying problem the Government must face immediately, with 300,000 unemployed already in Paris alone, or more than the national unemployment figure before the war.

Doriot's plan was:

1. Elimination from the big cities of workers who are not useful,

2. Elimination from production of all foreigners.

3. Institution of the family as the basis for salary and wage payments, thus returning the woman to her proper place in the home.

4. Organization of youth into special units where they would be trained for various trades.

5. A wide reclassification of professions, with unemployed workers being sent into those fields which have a shortage of labor, and new workers being dissuaded from entering overcrowded industries.
