

### ARMY MEDICAL COURSE ON WAY

'Freshener' Classes Scheduled by I. U. Center for Doctors.

Hoosier physicians, who forget what they learned in college just like everyone else, will be given an opportunity to "refreshen themselves" at a series of post-graduate courses to be given during the spring at the Indiana University School of Medicine.

The series will start about the middle of January with a weekly one-hour course for physicians interested in military medicine. They will be continued as long as interest in them justifies their existence, Dr. W. D. Gatch, dean of the school, said.

A two-week course in obstetrics, one of a series of three scheduled for this spring, will start Jan. 13 and continue to Jan. 25. A second will be held from April 14 to April 26 and the third from July 7 to July 19.

The annual intensive post-graduate course, covering most of the phases of medicine and surgery, will be held from April 28 to May 2. Afternoon and night courses in pediatrics will be given at the school on March 5, 12, 19 and 26 and a two-week course in otolaryngology will be held from April 13 to April 26. The final course of the year, from June 23 to June 27, will deal with heart disease.

### German-American Bund's Military Character Revealed by Manual, Dies Committee Says

WASHINGTON, Jan. 2 (U. P.).—The German-American Bund was described by the Dies Committee today as a "completely military" organization patterned after the "ruthlessly efficient" machine set up in Germany by Adolf Hitler.

The committee made public what it said was an exact translation of the official confidential manual of the Bund, which it offered as "fresh proof of the un-American character" of the organization, asserting that while its three years of investigation of the Bund had established its tie-up with Nazi Germany, the committee asserted that this was the first time the Bund's military character had been exposed.

The document, according to the committee, was obtained "after it had been taken from the personal effects of G. Wilhelm Kunze, fuhrer of the German-American Bund."

The military service of the Bund was shown to be governed by minute regulations governing drill, commands, and signals. The "signal to attack" was given as three long blasts on a whistle, and the instructions were: "OD men off duty and the roller command attack." The "roller command" is a detail of members assigned to "remove disturbers."

"The document also shows the absolute loyalty which is demanded of the Storm-Troopers in the German-American Bund—a loyalty which comes before everything else and extends to the minutest details of the Storm-Troopers' life," the committee said.

The paper outlined in detail the organization of the orderly service (known as OD) of the Bund. The Bund fuhrer is the ranking fuhrer of the Bund, but as his deputy in

letics, publicity, education and "propaganda and kultur."

Outlining the duties of a fuhrer, the manual asserts: "He will never criticize his superiors in the presence of his kammerads, but exhibit at all times an attitude of absolute loyalty and irreproachable conduct—such as he would expect from his subordinates. That blind obedience absolutely imperative under all circumstances can be assured only if the division displays a real spirit of kameradship that will confer respect and esteem upon its fuhrer."

"OD men and particularly OD fuhrers must submit proof of Aryan origin."

"The OD man guarantees the assurance, at the risk of his life if necessary, that our movement will continue to remain the relentless opponent of Jewish Marxism and the uncompromising champion of everything that constitutes American-Germania, even though such a course might be regarded as improper by any group within the Bund. . . . We want men who would exterminate with all their power the stinking poison of Red Jewish infection in America."

charge of od matters he appointed a national OD fuhrer, who also serves as an administrative officer of the Bund.

The national OD fuhrer's jurisdiction includes authority over administration, procurement and distribution of "equipment of the OD, its homes, etc., audit and control, personnel, employment, health, insurance, legal administration, athletics, publicity, education and "propaganda and kultur."

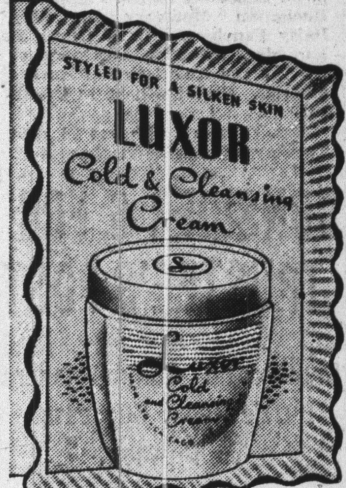
