

# HOOSIERS BACK CONVOY FIGHT

Both VanNuys and Willis Repeat Stand Against Entering War.

WASHINGTON, April 4.—Both Senators Frederick VanNuys (D. Ind.) and Raymond E. Willis (R. Ind.) will support the Toleby resolution to prohibit the use of United States ships to convoy war materials to England or elsewhere in the war zone, they asserted today.

As a member of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, Senator VanNuys expects to vote for the resolution's adoption, he declared.

Senator Willis was one of those invited to the executive session of isolationists in the Senate and House which met to formulate plans under the direction of Senator Burton K. Wheeler (D. Mont.), isolationist leader.

He said a previous engagement kept him from attending the first meeting Tuesday night, but that he favored the action taken to support the Toleby proposal.

## Cities Campaign Pledge

Senator VanNuys explained that he supported the Lease-Lend Bill only under the assurance from the Administration that convoys would not be used and thus the United States could keep out of actual warfare.

"I agreed with President Roosevelt when he said that 'convoys may mean shooting and shooting means war.' We do not want that unless the Western Hemisphere is attacked," Senator VanNuys said.

"The Toleby resolution sets forth this stand in unmistakable terms and I am for it 100 per cent. 'I made a campaign pledge in 1938 to keep American boys out of foreign wars and I intend to keep it.'"

Senator Willis said that he still does not intend to join any bloc bent on handicapping the Administration foreign policy, except to support such things as the Toleby resolution to keep America out of war.

"I will do my voting as my own conscience dictates, however," he added.

Senator Willis voted against the Lease-Lend Bill but for the seven billion dollar appropriation to implement it. Senator VanNuys supported both.

## Ludlow's Resolution

Rep. Louis Ludlow (D. Ind.) has offered a joint resolution in the House as follows:

"Resolved, That the United States of America covets no territory it does not now possess; it has no plans to extend its territorial domain and no intention of acquiring a single foot of foreign soil by war or conquest; it has no selfish interest in world affairs and no aim but service to humanity; and its supreme and only purpose is to protect, safeguard, and defend the great freedoms which are the basis of the American democracy and free democratic government everywhere."

The Indianapolis Congressman explained that going on record with such war aims would "thwart charges of selfishness and greed now being made against America by the Axis powers."

Author of the war referendum amendment known as the Ludlow Resolution, he voted against both the Lease-Lend and seven billion appropriation bills.

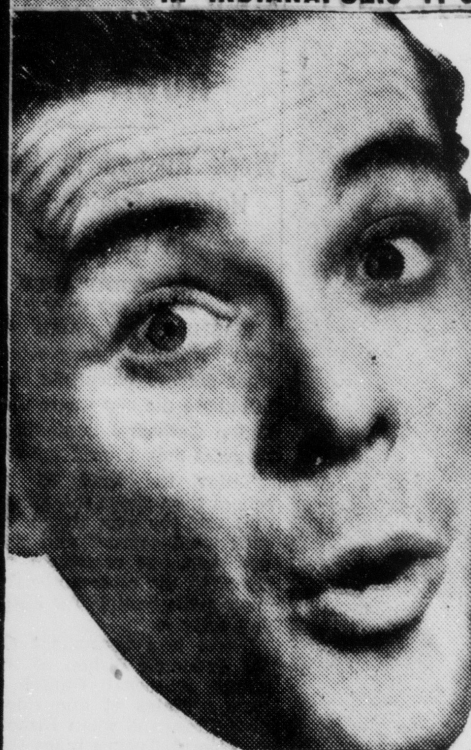
