## PLAN POST WAR JOBLESS FUND

Westinghouse Officials Set Up Reserve to Help Force Through Changeover.

PITTSBURGH, Feb. 12 (U. P.).—The Westinghouse Electric & Manufacturing Co. announced today a reserve fund is being built up for the benefit of employees who may be laid off in the future post-war days during the "change over from emergency war production to normal production."

Although its 78,000 employees now are working on \$350,000,000 of war orders, Westinghouse is assuring its workers of a "grub stake" during the "reconstruction period" after the war by establishing a special separation reserve fund in which it is setting aside an amount equal to one-half of 1 per cent of its payroll each month. The payroll now is running more than \$15,000,000 a month.

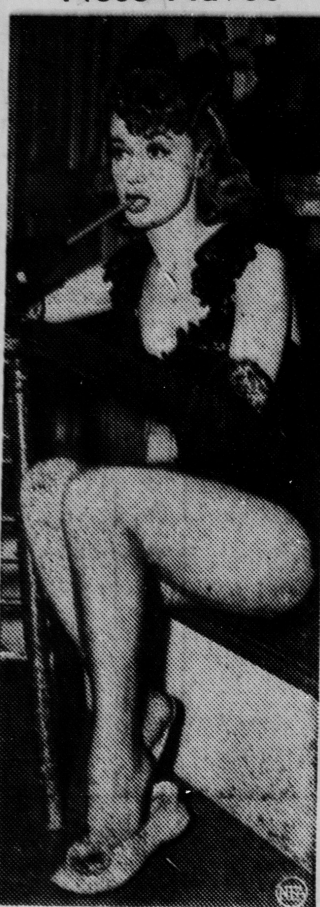
This separation reserve is being provided in addition to more than \$4,000,000 in Federal and State unemployment insurance payments made by Westinghouse in 1941. "Without withdrawing our attention from the present emergency, it is our responsibility to look ahead to the swing of the pendulum," said W. G. Marshall, Westinghouse vice president. "The present condition of having two jobs for one man will probably change to two men for one job. Meanwhile, the separation reserve plan will help give our employees a measure of security for the future."

Westinghouse also is organizing its facilities so the manufacture of its regular product can be resumed after the war with the "least possible inconvenience to its employees and customers," Mr. Marshall said.
