

NAZIS EXECUTE THREE IN PARIS

New Repression Campaign Is Launched Against French Patriots.

Radio broadcasts indicated that the Germans had embarked on a new merciless campaign of repression in France in an attempt to halt the terrorist activities of French patriots.

The Germans themselves announced the execution of three Frenchmen in Paris yesterday, bringing the total to 326.

London reported that the Germans intended to shoot 20 hostages at Tours tomorrow unless persons responsible for terrorist activities there were arrested meantime.

At Rouen, London said, the Germans proposed to execute 25 hostages Sunday unless they caught persons who threw a hand grenade at German troops.

2 Communists Jailed

Vichy reported that the Germans at Paris forbade Jews to leave their homes between 8 p. m. and 6 a. m. or to change their residences.

Vichy disclosed that "terrorists" exploded time bombs before the headquarters of three Paris suburban branches of the pro-German "Social Revolutionary Movement."

In Vichy, a court-martial sentenced two "Communists" to life imprisonment at hard labor for alleged attempts to "organize" Communist party units at Nice and Cannes.

The United Press recorded at New York a German broadcast that 42 persons had been executed yesterday at "Eau" as "incendiaries, murderers, seditious persons and protectors of Jews."

Apparently the date line was garbled and the real name of the town, or the country in which it was situated, could not be determined.

Thus it is that her tip to other young ladies is: When you find the right man, marry him, quick.


Miss Russell's husband of a few months is Fred Brisson, agent.

A SAILOR 'STEALS' RALLY SPOTLIGHT

MADISON, Ind., Feb. 13 (U.P.).—Seaman Paul Wells of Madison, home on furlough from Pearl Harbor, stole the spotlight from Governor Schricker and other officials at Jefferson County's defense bond rally last night with his plea for all-out war aid.

"There are two fronts in this war," the youthful sailor told his listeners. "The battle front all over the world is one, the production line is the other. Just keep them going. Remember the worker who lays down his tools is just as much of a traitor as the soldier who lays down his gun. You supply us with the equipment, and we'll do the fighting."

Rep. Earl Wilson of Indiana's Ninth District stressed the need for economy in all Federal expenditures not bearing on the war effort, while Governor Schricker declared "the people of Indiana are willing to do more than their share, but don't want any squandering of money."
